A Letter from the TDSB About Switching to Virtual Learning or Switching to Bricks and Mortar

A Letter from the TDSB (Re: switching to VL or BM in February 2022)

All Parents/Caregivers of Elementary Students,

As you know, all TDSB students selected either in-person or virtual learning for the 2021-22 school year. At the time of selection, we communicated that there would be one opportunity to switch between in-person and virtual learning in February 2022.

In order to plan ahead for elementary students to switch between in-person and virtual learning for February 2022, parents/caregivers and students requesting a change <u>must</u> complete an Elementary Switch Form between **Friday**, **December 3 and Friday**, **January 7**. A form must be completed for each student requesting a switch. Parents/caregivers and students who do not wish to make a change do not need to complete a form.

If you are considering a switch, please speak with your child before submitting a Switch Form. We expect that parents/caregivers with shared decision-making responsibilities will come to an agreement before completing the form.

A Letter from the TDSB (Re: switching to VL or BM in February 2022)

We recognize that we are asking for this decision well in advance of February and thank you for your understanding, as this process takes time to complete. While we cannot guarantee that all switch requests will be met, it is our goal to accommodate as many as possible based on available programs and space (e.g. French Immersion, Extended French, Specialized Programs, Alternative Schools, other limited circumstances).

More information about the Elementary Switch Form will be shared directly with parents/caregivers on December 3. Elementary classes will reflect changes due to switches beginning on **February 22, 2022**.

Whether you choose a switch in learning model or not, a limited number of teachers or classes (or school for virtual learning classes) may change due to a possible re-organization.





This Week @ Corvette



Mr. Ramirez has been working with Ms. Raj's, Ms. Djacoure's and Ms. Atri's students in science.




They are learning how to build strong and stable structures and are going to share some of their structures with you today.

One of the most important things we can do to slow the spread of COVID-19 in our schools, is for <u>students</u> to screen themselves daily for any symptoms of COVID-19 and also follow the circumstances in which they should stay home.

Students and families will need to screen themselves each morning. Parents should sign their child's <u>TDSB</u> <u>Student Health Pass</u> daily before arriving at school. Their child will need to present this to their teacher each morning.

- 2. Does anyone in your household have one or more COVID-19 symptoms and/or are waiting for test results after experiencing symptoms?
 - If the child/student is fully vaccinated* or has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 90 days and been cleared, select "No".
- 3. In the last 10 days, has the child/student tested positive on a rapid antigen test or a homebased self-testing kit?
 - · If they have since tested negative on a lab-based PCR test, select "No".
- 4. Has the child/student been notified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19 or been told to stay home and self-isolate?
 - If the child/student is fully vaccinated* or has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 90 days and been cleared or public health has said the child/student does not have to self-isolate, select "No".
- 5. In the last 14 days has the child/student travelled outside of Canada AND been advised to quarantine per the <u>federal quarantine requirements</u> QR was told not to attend school/ child care?

Please note addition of: If the student has travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days and was told not to attend school, then the student(s) should stay home.

This revised Toronto Public Health screening does take into account COVID vaccine status of students (aged 12+).

This revised Toronto Public Health screening does indicate that if anyone in their household is experiencing one or more of COVID-19 symptoms or are waiting for COVID test results then the student should stay home, and self isolate.

TDSB Student Health Pass

Corvette students will receive a copy of the TDSB Student Health Pass and Screening Questionnaire on the first day of school.

Please go through the student health pass with your child daily, sign it and send it with your child to school.

Your child will present this signed portion to their teacher each morning before entry to school.

TDSB Student Health Pass

The most important thing families can do to help slow the spread of COVID-19, is to screen their children daily for any COVID-19 symptoms and keep them home from school if they are sick or have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19.

Review this COVID-19 checklist daily with your child. Sign* below each day to confirm that your child or anyone else in the household does not have any symptoms or have other exposure to COVID-19. We all have a role in keeping our schools safe and healthy.


