

TDSB Student Health Pass



1. Does the child/student have any of the following new or worsening symptoms?**







Cough



Difficulty breathing



Decrease or loss of taste/smell



Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea

 If the child/student has a health condition diagnosed by a health care provider that gives them the symptom, select "No". If the symptom is new, different or getting worse, select "Yes".

If "YES" to any symptom:



Stay home & self-isolate



Get teste





One of the most important things we can do to slow the spread of COVID-19 in our schools, is for <u>students</u> to screen themselves daily for any symptoms of COVID-19 and also follow the circumstances in which they should stay home.

Students and families will need to screen themselves each morning.

Parents should sign their child's TDSB Student Health Pass daily before arriving at school. Their child will need to present this to their teacher each morning.

2. Does anyone in your household have one or more symptoms of COVID-19 and/or are waiting for test results after having symptoms?	Yes
 If the child/student is fully vaccinated* or has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 90 days and been cleared, select "No". 	No
3. In the last 10 days, has the child/student tested positive on a rapid antigen test or a home-based self-testing kit?	Yes No
 If they have since tested negative on a lab-based PCR test, select "No". 	
4. Has the child/student been notified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19 or been told to stay home and self-isolate?	Yes No
 If the child/student is fully vaccinated* or has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 90 days and been cleared or public health has said the child/student does not have to self-isolate, select "No". 	
5. In the last 14 days, has the child/student travelled outside of Canada AND been advised to quarantine per the <u>federal quarantine requirements</u> ?	Yes No

This revised Toronto Public Health screening does take into account COVID vaccine status of students (aged 12+).

This revised Toronto Public Health screening does indicate that if family members experience one or more of COVID-19 symptoms then the student should also stay home, and self isolate.

TDSB Student Health Pass

Corvette students will receive a copy of the TDSB Student Health Pass and Screening Questionnaire on the first day of school.

Please go through the student health pass with your child daily, sign it and send it with your child to school.

Your child will present this signed portion to their teacher each morning before entry to school.

TDSB Student Health Pass

The most important thing families can do to help slow the spread of COVID-19, is to screen their children daily for any COVID-19 symptoms and keep them home from school if they are sick or have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19.

Review this COVID-19 checklist daily with your child. Sign* below each day to confirm that your child or anyone else in the household does not have any symptoms or have other exposure to COVID-19. We all have a role in keeping our schools safe and healthy.



Please take time to talk to your children, especially the youngest learners, about what to expect on Tuesday afternoon. We will do the same at school.


Please take this time to also consider creating a home fire evacuation plan.

School Bus for Students in French Immersion



From September 9 to September 14, 2021 – only students with special education needs (excluding those in the gifted program) who travel to school on mini buses, mini vans, taxis and Wheelchair accessible vehicles will be provided with student transportation.

Starting September 15, 2021 –all other eligible students will be provided with student transportation, unless there is a significant driver shortage or other unforeseen issues related to COVID-19.

Empty Seat Policy

Once again, the TDSB's <u>Empty Seat Policy</u> (PR504) has been put on hold for the 2021-22 school year to help promote physical distancing on school busses, as well as to help the TSTG and bus operators effectively plan bus routes and seating arrangements in line with the COVID-19 health and safety precautions.

Water Bottles

Water fountains cannot be used this year.

Corvette has installed numerous water bottle fill stations throughout the school and students are encouraged to bring and use reusable water bottles. Water bottle fill stations are accessible throughout the school year.





Safe Arrival

Student well-being and safety are top priorities at our school. One important measure we take is our Safe Arrival Program, which helps to ensure students have arrived at school safely and when expected.

If your child is going to be late or absent for any reason, it is important that you contact the office immediately and report the reason for the absence.

At the Toronto District School Board (TDSB) we have an automated call-out system. If your child is late or absent, without informing the school ahead of time, the call-out system will attempt to contact you.

Pedestrian Safety Tip



Children under ten should be accompanied by adults or older children when crossing the street. At this age, their judgment and perceptual skills are still immature, yet they often eagerly try to cross streets on their own in order to demonstrate some independence. Learn more https://bit.ly/2ETzMO5.

Teach children how to cross the street safely. Teach them to stop (before stepping onto the road), look left, right and left again, and listen for traffic before stepping out into the street. Teach children to wait until the street is clear and to keep looking until they have crossed the street. They should also look the driver in the eye before crossing.


