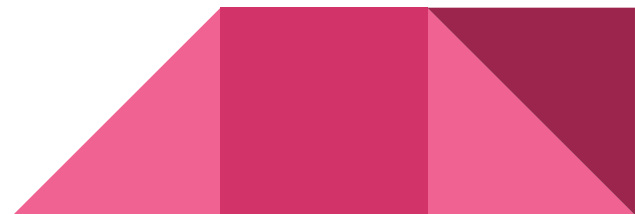


Masks

As of March 21, masks will be strongly encouraged in TDSB schools, though not required.

However, you must wear a mask:

- For days 6-10 after a self-isolation period of five days after a COVID-19 diagnosis. [Learn more](#).

- In public spaces, including schools and childcares, **for the first 14 days following travel outside of Canada**. [Learn more](#).

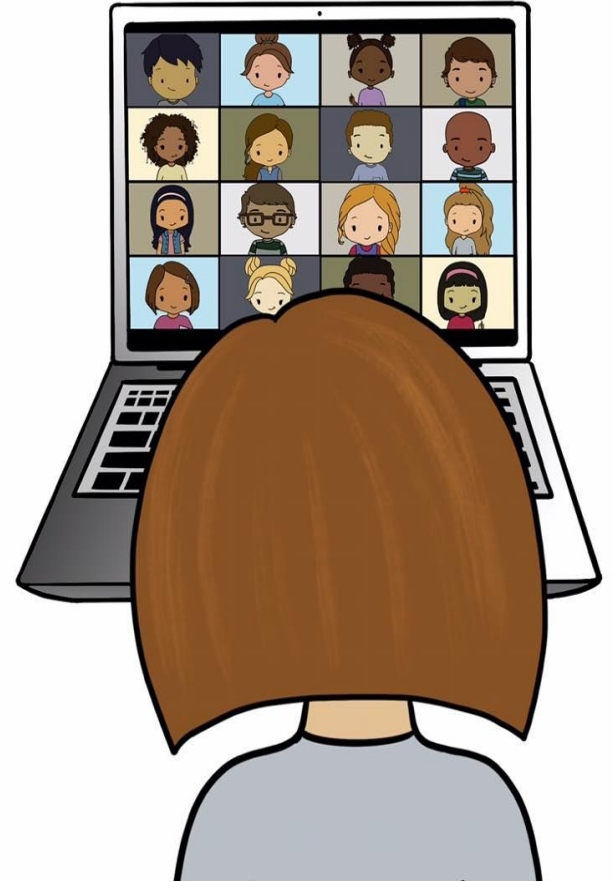
Virtual Learning 2022-23

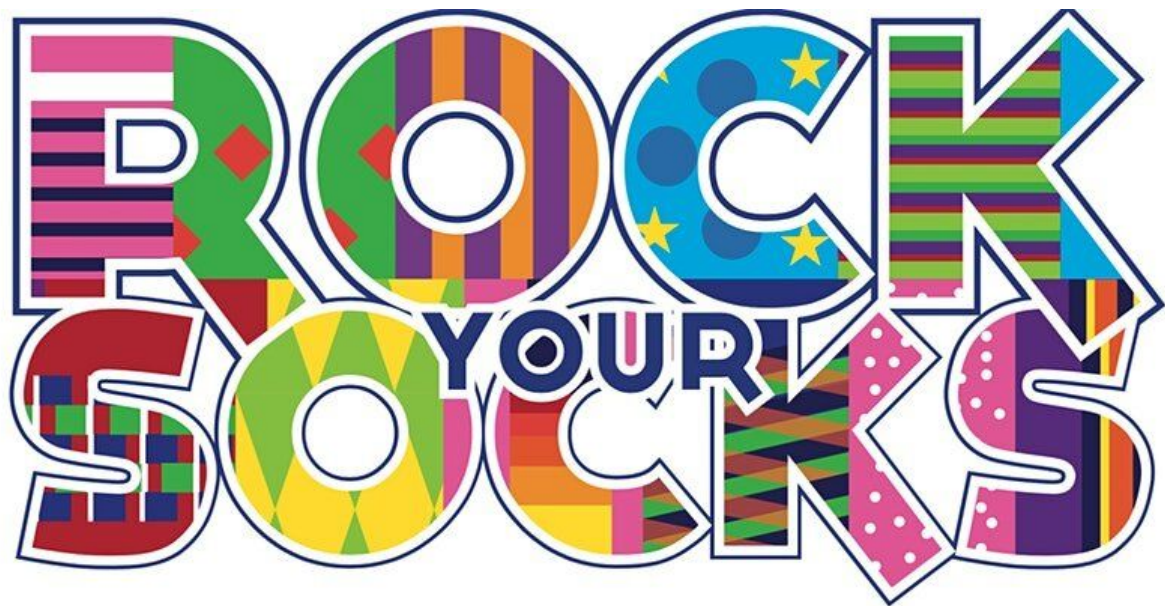


Autism Awareness Day

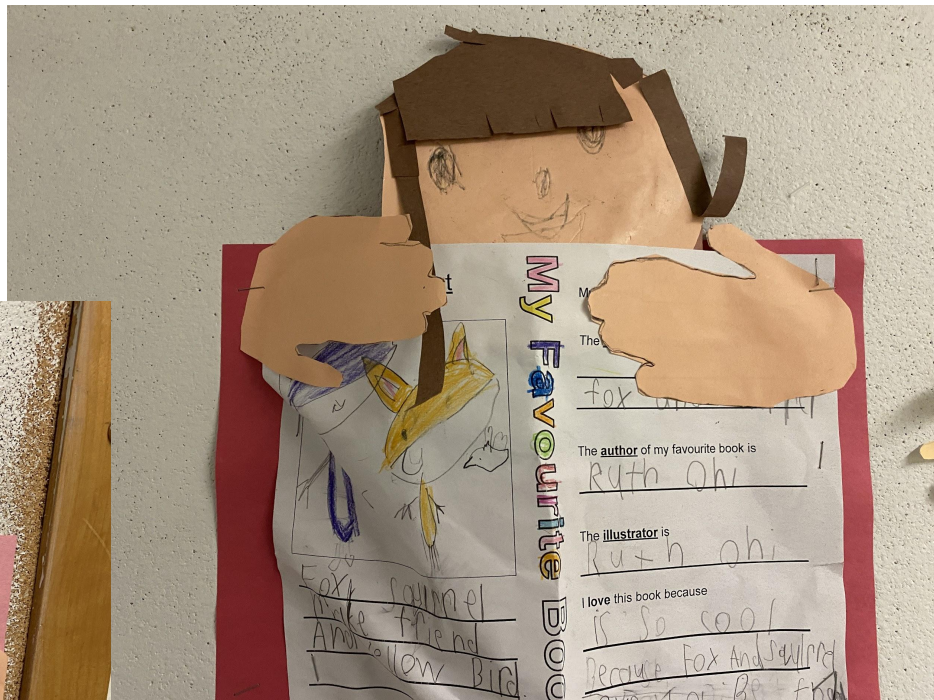
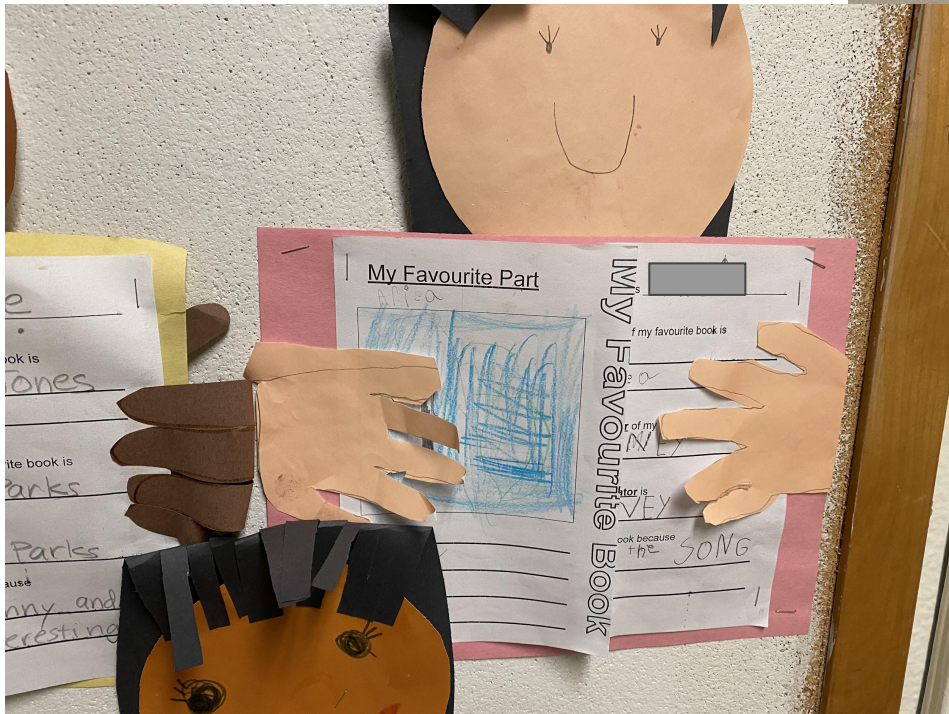
Choice and Voice

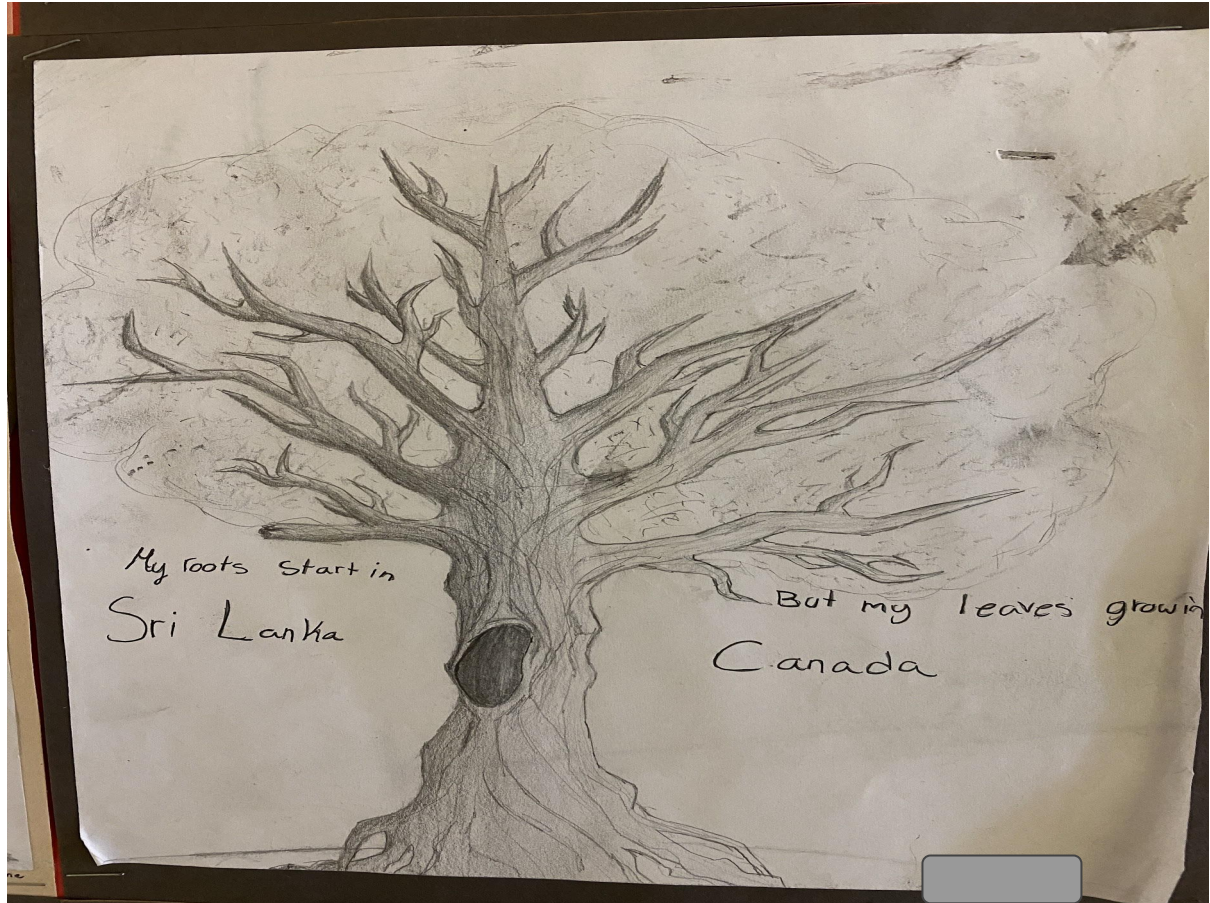
Students in Grades 5 and 6 are learning tessellations.

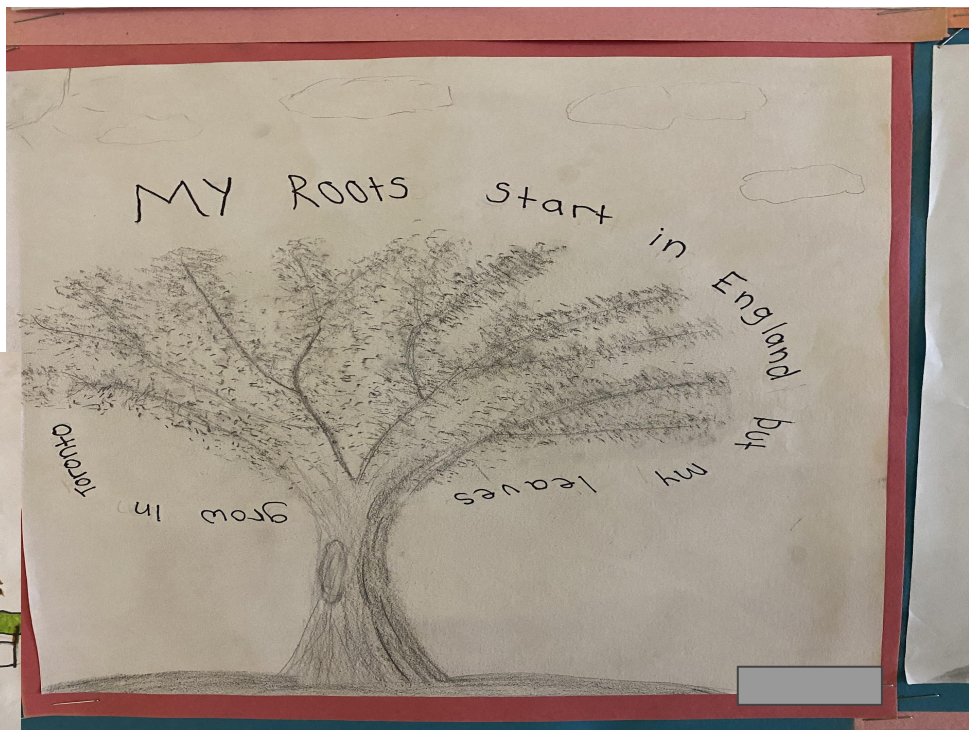
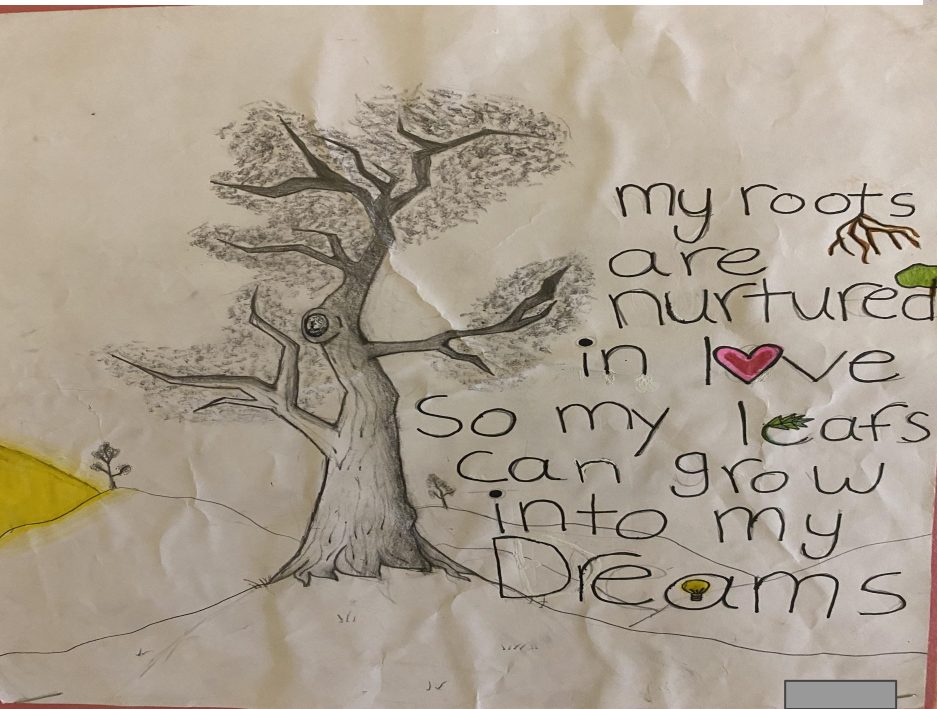


Roots and Routes

The Grade 6 students in Room 34 are exploring this idea of roots and routes!





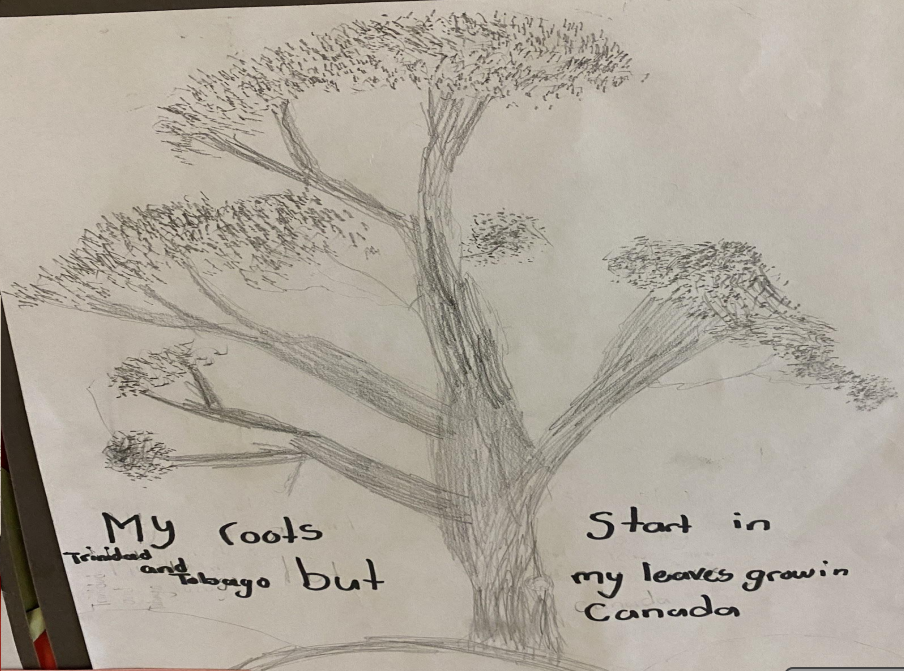
