The goal of the council this year is to represent parent's views, opinions and ideas to the school administration. It is vitally important for us to receive constructive feedback from the general parent population.

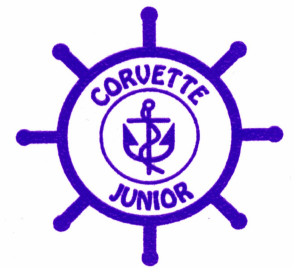
