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Grade 7 & 8 Students - Life, Education and Career Planning using MyBlueprint

Grade 7&8 students at Cosburn MS have participated in the MyBlueprint workshop to either create an account or continue in to developing their Individual Pathways Plan (IPP) as mandated by the Ministry of Education. The url is www.myblueprint.ca/tdsb.

Students should be working towards 100% completion of their IPP by the end of the school year. Mr. Daniele has facilitated the use of the web-based tool and many students are well on their way completing Goal Setting exercises, Learning Style assessments and reflections accordingly.

Parents/Guardians are encouraged to sit down with their Grade 7/8 child so that they may create a "Parent" account that will allow them to link with their child's IPP.

This is a useful tool in helping students and parents to plan for decisions around high school and post-secondary pathways as well.

Dieppe Park Rink

Grade 7 & 8 Parents:

The rink at Dieppe Park rink is popular at lunchtime for our students. We have a number of students who have come with hockey sticks and skates to school to take advantage of the outdoor rink.

The only concern raised here is safety. Many of the students do not bring helmets, and as a school we are unable to supervise the activities at Dieppe Park. We are asking parents to please send a letter to school letting us know that it is fine for your

daughter/son to skate during the lunch hour and speak with your children about returning to school on time after lunch if they have gone to Dieppe.

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They must be wearing CSA approved helmets.



Cold Weather and Winter Safety Reminders

Children need an opportunity to get exercise and free play time outdoors, however, weather conditions sometimes warrant that lunch periods and pre-entry periods be considered necessary for student and staff safety.

According to TDSB policy,

When temperature and/or windchill factor indicates -28C or lower children will remain indoors due to risk of frostnip and frostbite. When temperature and/or windchill factor indicates -20 to -28C, outside lunch recess will only be 20 minutes. If parents have any questions or concerns about how and when weather conditions affect your child's school day, please contact the school office.
