In improvisation there is no script. The performers have a rough idea of the storyline and then they make up or adjust the story as they go along. During the show, they also invite audience members to come up and take part in the play. All of the students become involved by having to listen for certain cue words or phrases to which they must respond. it's so much fun!

AT THE END OF EACH SESSION, STUDENTS ARE OFTEN PROVIDED WITH A STICKER BADGE SO THEY CAN FEEL LIKE HONORARY OFFICERS. WE APPRECIATE THIS PARTNERSHIP AND LOOK FORWARD TO HAVING OUR OFFICERS IN THE BUILDING EACH WEEK.

We look forward to hosting the Book Fair and having students get new books that they can enjoy reading.


CODING WITH DASH ROBOTS

At Dallington, students have the exciting opportunity to work in the library, coding our Dash robots to solve specific challenges. Coding involves creating a sequence of instructions that guide an electronic device to perform tasks. In this session, Mrs. Mehta's class took on the challenge set by Mr. Ellinidis: to program Dash to navigate out of the rain and seek shelter.

The students at Dallington thoroughly enjoy coding with Dash, and it's clear this activity is a favourite, as they engage in learning, laughter, and growth. Through these collaborative sessions in the library, we aim to inspire students and equip them with the tools to imagine and shape the future. By working with Dash robots, students are developing critical skills in creative thinking, systematic reasoning, and teamwork.

Congrats to the Yellow House who won Dallington's first house cup! They are the winners for November. They worked as a team, ensuring their members participated in large numbers.






111 and 112 have been learning about

Strong and Stable structures!


