## 1. Updates on Current Fundraising Events: Jackie

-teacher appreciation lunch May 25 (Thursday): asking parents for a donation of some kind
-pizza lunch, Venessa will address later on: some parents were complaining that we had too many pizza lunches, so Venessa is looking at a couple of different options for next year:
-one slice is 3.50 , we are looking to lower the price to about 3.00 per slice because of complaints, went from 8 slices in first term to 12 slices in the next.
-maybe if we spread out the lunches to 20 lunches over 3 terms
-financial decrease with the more number of slices you buy (up to 6-8 slices), one form per family
