3. Dallington Pollinators: <u>Mahnaz Ghalib (Community member)</u>

- Dallington pollinator garden, run by volunteers
- Had rainwater harvesting system installed recently
- Helps students learn about food insecurity, habitat and pollinator protection, growing food, etc.
- There is an after school garden club for students
- Unfortunately, the garden has been experiencing vandalism issues
- Have received a grant to run outdoor garden labs for the students
- Volunteers gather Saturday mornings, please join if interested!
- Participating in hosting ravine walks
- Will host the community pumpkin walk the evening after Halloween

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4. Financial update: Treasurers – Vanessa Sandy

- Beginning balance for 2022/2023 school year is \$3,448
- Most revenue comes from pizza lunches
- \$25k went to the playground fund last school year

5. Long term project and Master Plan: David Hawker-Budlovsky

Intro and update on outdoor play area on school grounds

- Playground that the students currently use is old and on city of Toronto property, so there is a fear that it may be removed some day
- This led into revisioning and planning new outdoor play areas on school grounds
- Some items have already been implemented: basketball courts, tree planting, outdoor classroom area
- Still coming: accessibility path at the front, side, and back of the school, amphitheatre at back of school, pathway at back of school, sand play at back of school.
- After accessibility path at the side of the school is installed, we will then work with the city to connect the Dallington path to the city path nearby.
- Timeline for phase 2: project is ready to go into tender and will hopefully will be completed in the 2023 construction season (maybe between April and October).
- PAC has raised all the funds needed to pay for phase 2 construction

7. Principal's and Vice Principal updates and comments

- New principal Frank Costa with many years experience
- Welcome to several new teachers
- Please come to meet & greet on October 3rd
- Field trips have been planned and are underway
- Dallington will be reorganizing students due to change in numbers/population
