## **Type of Programs at Ontario Colleges:**

- ✓ Certificate Programs two semesters (one year) of study.
- ✓ **Diploma Programs** 4 semesters (two years) of study.
- ✓ Advanced Diploma Programs 6 semesters (three years of study).
- ✓ **Degree Programs** four years of study
- ✓ Collaborative & Joint Degree Programs offered jointly by a college and partnering university students earn both college and university credits.
- ✓ Co-op & Apprenticeship Programs all colleges offer a variety of these.
