**Take Your Kids to Work Day \*NEW:** On Wednesday, November 4th, 2020 your child/ward will have the opportunity to participate in Take

Our Kids to Work Day. Launched in 1994 by The Learning Partnership and with the TDSB, Take Our Kids to Work Day is an experiential learning opportunity for Grade 9 students across Canada offering them the chance to see the world of work firsthand, explore a variety of careers and sectors, and look at what skills are important to thrive in the world of work.

Students in grade 9 will have two options. Students can participate by:

- 1. going with their parents/guardians to organized events hosted by the employer (in-person/virtually).
- 2. attending their afternoon class and being led by their teacher through a virtual Take Our Kids to Work Day, which may include viewing The Learning Partnership's virtual events and career-related activities in the classroom, before, on and after Wednesday, November 4th. If your child/ward will be attending organized events by your employer, please notify the school and they will be marked as excused. Students will be responsible for any work missed. Tests/evaluations

will not be scheduled on this day. Please complete the following FORM by N

Course Withdrawal: Monday November 2nd is the last day students can withdraw from courses without the credit appearing on the student transcript. Students have five (5) days after teachers communicate mid-term marks (week of October 19-23, 2020) to withdraw from their course without the credit appearing on their transcript. Generally, students who have over 23 credits and are in their final year can withdraw from a course.\_Consultation with Guidance is important to make sure that students continue to fulfil their graduation requirements. Drop date deadlines for each quadmester are:

Quadmester 1: November 2, 2020
Quadmester 2: January 18, 2021
Quadmester 3: April 5, 2021
Quadmester 4: June 7, 2021

<u>Students Not Feeling Well</u> \*NEW Families and students are reminded that if students are feeling unwell then they MUST stay home and follow the COVID protocol Please ensure you take the time to

If students will be missing tests, assignments or other evaluations then they should reach out by email to their teachers and alternate arrangements will be made. Families should have a 'pick-up' plan ready in the event this happens. If a student is sent home because they are showing symptoms a "Return to School Form" needs to be filled out and signed. This form will be given to the student and family. If a student is ill off-site we can scan/send the form.
