Quad 2 *NEW: Quad 2 begins this Monday, November 23. We welcome back those students who were with us in Quad 1 as well as some students who are returning to us from the TDSB Virtual Secondary School. Most students should have already received their timetables. They are also available in the TDSB Connects App.

The vast majority of DMCI Quad 1 students will be continuing with in-person learning for Quad 2. Less than 15% of students opted to continue their learning on-line with DMCI for Quad 2.

For Quad 2, some cohorts will be all in person and some will be all virtual. Slightly over 20% of our cohorts will be a combination of students learning together on-line and in-person simultaneously.

All virtual students should have received an email reminding them that they are virtual and explaining how to read the timetable. If you completed the Google form to indicate that you wished to switch to virtual learning at DMCI and did not receive the email, please contact Mr. Stoitsiadis.

No student who selected in-person learning has been moved to a virtual-only class or vice versa.

DMCI Covid-19 ***UPDATE**: As of today, Friday, Nov. 20, 2 p.m., we have one active case of Covid in a Gr. 11 student and no active cases amongst staff. All other cases are now considered to be resolved. As a precautionary measure, one group of Gr. 10 students will continue self-isolating until the end of the day on Monday.

If a student or staff has tested positive for Covid-19 or has been a close contact of someone who has, they must self-isolate as per Toronto Public Health direction and may only return to school once they have been cleared to do so. Please inform the school immediately if you ever test positive for Covid-19 or have been a "close contact" of someone who has tested positive.

Please ensure that you and your families always follow Toronto Public Health protocols both inside the building and also, very importantly, at all times in the community, at home, etc. Toronto Public Health did not find evidence of transmission inside the school building. This is excellent! At the same time, all of our actions anywhere have an impact on everyone here so it is essential that everyone follows the protocols everywhere in order to maintain everyone's safety. For confidentiality reasons, we are not able to provide detailed information about active or resolved Covid-19 cases, however, if you have specific questions or concerns about Covid-19 and DMCI, please feel free to contact Mr. Bushell at 416-395-3190, ext. 20010.

Asynchronous Attendance *NEW: Teachers are now required to take attendance during the Asynchronous periods for all students. Teachers will be sharing attendance instructions with students via Google Classroom, Brightspace or email. Students are to login each morning of their Asynchronous period at 9 am, complete the Google Form (or alternate instructions provided by the teacher) then log off again. A reminder that the Asynchronous period is a time for students to do independent work on homework, projects or any other outstanding tasks provided by teachers.
