#### **Health and Safety Protocols**

\*\*It is of the utmost importance that parents/guardians screen each of their children <u>every morning</u> before they come to school and sign their Health Pass each day. <u>If your child is sick or is</u> <u>displaying any of the COVID-19 symptoms or</u> <u>someone in your household is displaying symptoms,</u> <u>you must keep your child(ren) at home.</u>

If a student comes to school and is displaying any of the COVID-19 symptoms, the student will go to our school's Wellness Room and they <u>must</u> be picked up from school as quickly as possible. If your child is sent home, the office staff will review the protocols with you for your child to be able to return to school. Thank you for your continued cooperation and support.
