



## **SUMMER INTERNSHIPS FOR TRADES EXPLORATION (SITE) PROGRAM:**

George Brown College and Geneva Centre for Autism

We are currently looking for participants for our SITE program.

The SITE program provides young adults with Autism Spectrum Disorder with an opportunity to explore different career options in the trades and develop confidence in their ability to pursue employment or studies.

In the mornings, participants will have a chance to attend George Brown classes and labs to learn about different trades (including culinary and construction). In the afternoons, participants will have an opportunity to work on their professional developmental skills at Geneva Centre for Autism.

The program runs Monday - Friday (10:00 am - 4:30 pm) for a duration of two weeks. The program is free.

To be eligible, participants:

- Must be able to travel independently by TTC
- Must be able to read at a minimum grade 6 level
- Must have a reliable system of communication

We will be offering the program twice:  
May 4th - 15th, 2015 and June 15th - 26th, 2015.
