#### **Out-of-Area Admission**

(formerly Optional Attendance)



- Students can apply to attend a school other than their designated school by address.
- Applicants will apply online through a central application that will be posted on the Out-of-Area Admissions website
- If you require support completing the form, please contact your current school.

- Families may select up to one (1) school.
- Once submitted it cannot be changed online. You will need to contact your current school.



- Families will be contacted via email.
- Please do not contact schools directly for results or updates.



#### **Out-of-Area Admission School Status**

### **Bethune is Limited**

- All students may apply for Out-of-Area Admissions.
- The school may admit students from all of the priorities, as space is available.
- Transportation is the responsibility of the applicant.



### **Application Timelines**

**January 8, 2024** - Secondary Out-of-Area Admissions Online application opens

January 26, 2024 (4:00 p.m.) - Secondary Out-of-Area Admissions Online application closes



### **Acceptances Timelines**

- **Round 1: Wednesday, February 7, 2024** Families to be informed of the status of the application.
  - Tuesday, February 13 at 4 p.m Families must confirm acceptance of the offer by this time.
- Round 2: Wednesday February 14, 2024 Families to be informed of the status of the application.
  - Tuesday, February 20 at 4 p.m. Families must confirm acceptance of the offer by this time.
- **Final Round: Wednesday February 21, 2024** Families to be informed of the final status of the application request. <u>All waitlists expire.</u>
  - Friday, February 23 at 4 p.m. Families must confirm acceptance of the offer by this time.
- Monday, February 26, 2024 TDSB Students must finalize their acceptance by completing and submitting the corresponding course selection for the accepted school in myBlueprint by this date.



## Out-of-Area Admissions: Random Selection Priorities

- Spaces will be filled by grade according to admission priorities.
- For each of the admission priorities listed below, if the number of applications exceeds available spaces, a random selection process will be undertaken until the available seats are filled.



## Out-of-Area Admissions: Random Selection Priorities

Priority 1: (Elementary Schools only\*\*) Students who have a sibling currently attending the requested school and that sibling will still be attending the requested school the next school year.

**Note:** \*\*Students attending a secondary school as of September 2022 may have the sibling rule apply to their younger siblings.

**Priority 2: Students currently attending a feeder school** in the same program as the application to the requested school (i.e., in a regular program if applying to a regular program).



## Out-of-Area Admissions: Random Selection Priorities

Priority 3: (Elementary Schools only) Current students no longer attending the Before- and After-School Program of the requested school. wishing to remain at the school (see section 6.2.2 of P013) and current students who have moved and wish to remain at the school.

**Priority 4: Current TDSB students** (and who remain registered as TDSB students for the duration of the school year in which the Outof-Area application was made).

**Priority 5:** Other students whose parents'/caregivers' primary residence is in the City of Toronto (e.g., from independent/private schools, other school boards, home schooling, etc.).

**Priority 6:** Students whose parents'/guardians' primary residence is outside the City of Toronto.
