What is SHSM?

A Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) is a Ministry-approved specialized program that allows students to focus their learning on a specific economic sector while meeting the requirements for graduation.

What does SHSM look like at Bethune?

At Bethune the economic sector that we have been approved for is the *Business* sector. The SHSM program helps students who are interested in the Business Sector transition from High School to University, College, Apprenticeship, or the Workplace.

What does SHSM look like at Bethune?

The Business SHSM program at Bethune allows students to experience a range of customized learning opportunities in the area of Business, through industry recognized certifications, related "Reach Ahead Activities" and real world Business sector experiences.

- Business SHSM is a 2 year program (Grade 11 and 12) and students must complete the following five components:
- 9 COURSES (4 MAJOR, 2 COOP, 2 MATH, 1 ENGLISH)
- **✓** 6 CERTIFICATIONS
- REACH AHEAD EXPERIENCES
- **✓** EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING & CAREER EXPLORATION
- ✓ SECTOR PARTNER EXPERIENCE (SPE)




