What is SHSM?

A Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) is a Ministry-approved specialized program that allows students to focus their learning on a specific economic sector while meeting the requirements for graduation.

What does SHSM look like at Bethune?

At Bethune the economic sector that we have been approved for is the *Business* sector.

The SHSM program helps students who are interested in the Business Sector transition from High School to University, College, Apprenticeship training, or the Workplace.

What does SHSM look like at Bethune?

The Business SHSM program at Bethune allows students to experience a range of **customized learning opportunities** in the area of Business, through:

- industry recognized certifications
 - related "Reach Ahead Activities"
- real world Business sector experiences

- Business SHSM is a **2 year program** (Grade 11 and 12) and students must complete the following five components:
- 9 COURSES (4 MAJOR, 2 CO-OP, 2 MATH, 1 ENGLISH)
- ✓ 6 CERTIFICATIONS (ex. CPR Level C, First Aid, WHMIS)
- REACH AHEAD EXPERIENCE
- **✓** EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING & CAREER EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES
- ✓ SECTOR PARTNER EXPERIENCE (SPE)







Your sibling will be back at Bethune next school year 2025-2026.



Feeder School (Priority 2)

Students currently attending a feeder school of Bethune in the same program as the application to the requested school (i.e. in Regular program if applying to Regular program)


