

Introduction & Welcome - Pete

• Pete showed the agenda to the council. He asked if anybody wanted any additions added to it. Everyone was fine with the agenda.

Minutes reviewed from prior meeting - Naadia

- Pete motions to verify the minutes
- Naadia mentioned that Nat wrote the minutes for the first meeting as I wasn't voted in as the secretary yet. The minutes had been previously circulated for approval



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- Nat approved the minutes.
- Azadeh seconded the approval of the minutes.

School Update (See separate Principal's Update for full report) - Julie Kwon

- Progressive reports were sent out to parents in November
- Extracurricular activities at Dunlace are run by staff
- Some examples of these activities are Chess club, Eco club, Bracelet making club, and volleyball
- For Sk to grade 2 government now requires complete screening, progress was sent to parents about this
- English text different from French text
- If your child didn't meet the benchmark, don't worry, just a guideline for what to work on with students.
- This is about literacy programming
- Optional to screen past the spring if your kid did not meet benchmark.
- A lot in curriculum about Indigenous learning
- Executive of School Council received budget proposal
- Thursday, Dec. 12th is the winter concert
- Choir performed at Queen's park
- They are asked back each year.
- Stephanie bowman MPP was there to watch them.
- 2:30pm Friday, Dec. 20th parents invited for a holiday celebration.
- Junior boys volleyball going on to Regionals

- Pete said council wants to communicate directly to parents, but don't have access to a parent council email yet. **ACTION ITEM:** Julie will look into getting this access to council chairs.
- Ms. Julie Kwon mentioned the donations for the food bank.
- Naadia asked Ms. Julie Kwon if they would have a competition between classes to donate food like they did for sock donations in the past. Ms. Hannah said they will do this, this year. The winning class will get popcorn and a movie.
- Kind club is in charge of encouraging classes to compete bringing food for donations.
- More of the Principal's update will be put in a separate document.

Financial Update - Somaya and Azadeh (Budget is in another document)

- Somaya went over changes in budget; she added custodial fees of \$500 per event and reduced expenses to only 1 jungle sport vs. 2.
- Still need to incorporate teachers' proposal \$5500 allocated in the current budget vs. over \$7000 in teachers' proposal. **ACTION ITEM:** The executive of the council will discuss this further in early January and then get back to Julie Kwon and teachers about their decision in late January.
- Azadeh went over bank statements from September until now.
