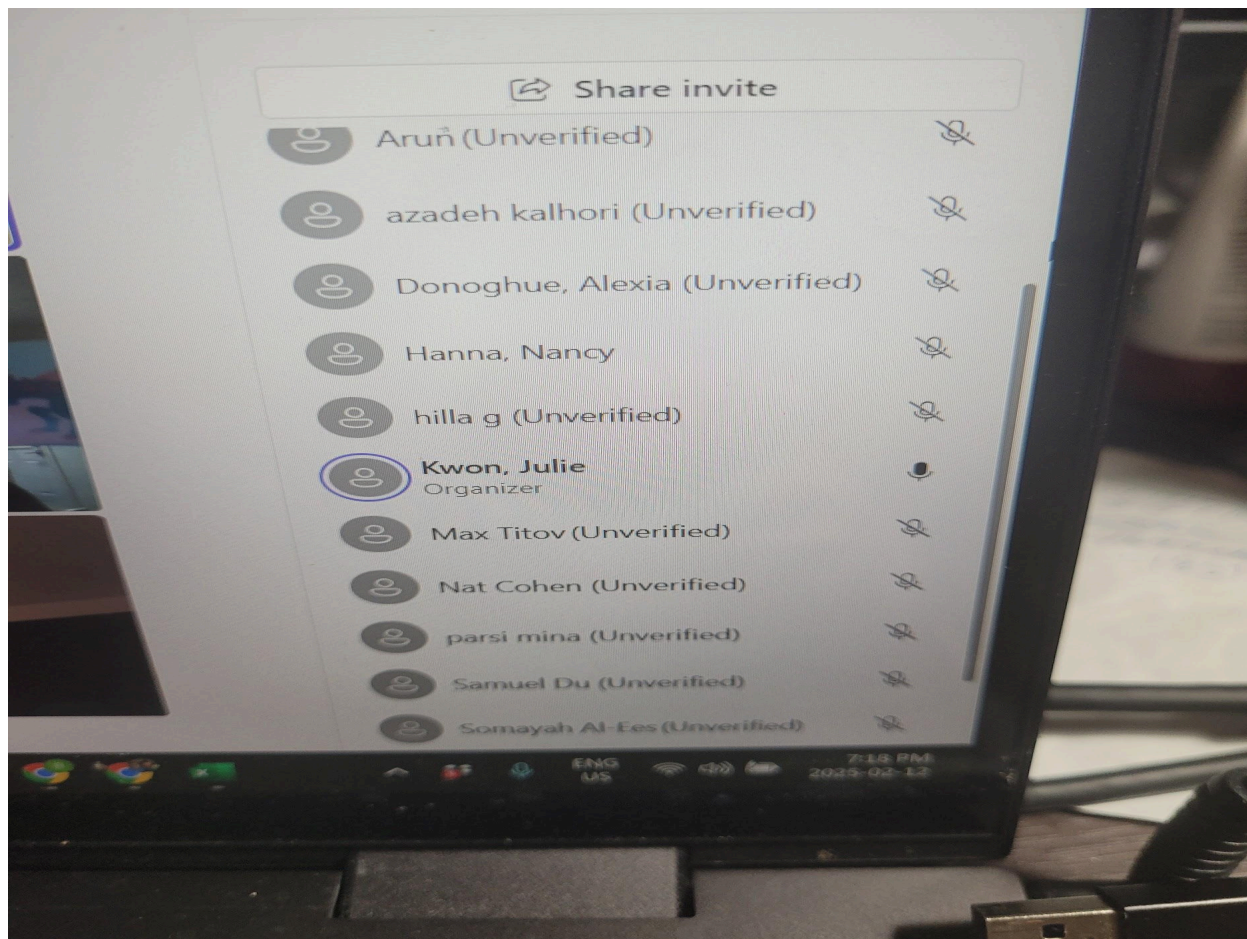

Financial Update - Somayah and Azadeh ([Budget is in the attached linked document](#))

- Somayah presented the budget. She pointed out some key *actual income*, just to name a few lunch program, fun fair event, family donations (\$600), Valentine's program (actual was \$475; was expecting \$750), Grade 5 fundraising, games night (actual was \$1454, was expecting \$2000)
- For expenses, Somayah pointed out some actuals, just to name a few, here are some numbers, \$2970 for the fun fair, jungle sports was \$250 more than budgeted, games night was under budget at \$888 actual (vs. budgeted \$2200).
- The reserve is \$12,695 right now.
