

Crosstown LRT Project – Update, January 25, 2019

Crosstown has informed the Toronto District School Board that crews will return to Brownlow Ave and Eglinton Ave to connect to the new storm sewer system installed last year. The work will involve concrete chipping.

Details

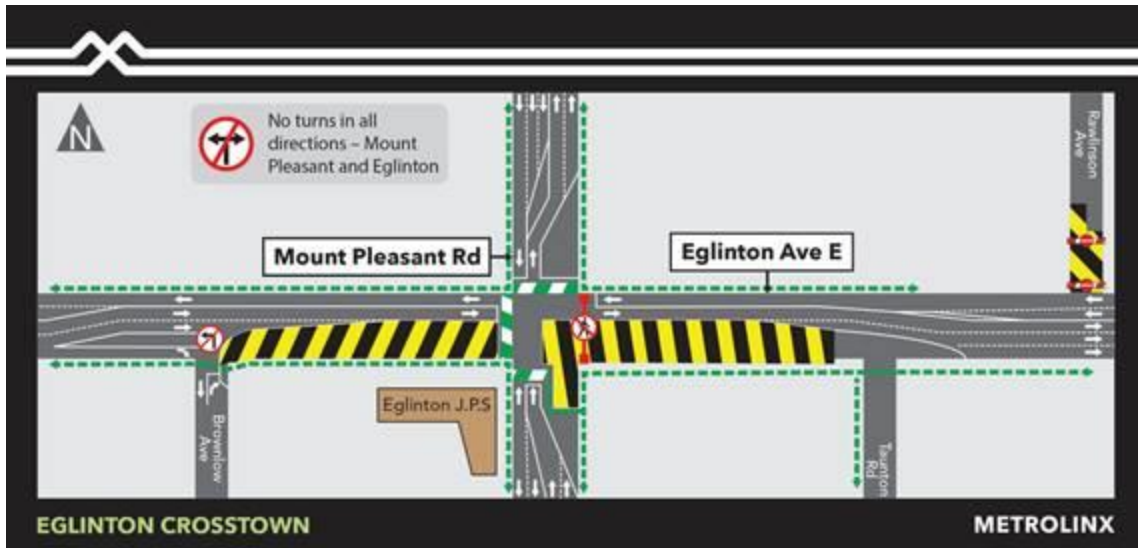
Work will start on Wednesday, January 30, 2019 for approximately 3 to 5 days. Construction will take on a 24-hour basis.

What to Expect

The fence on the south side of Eglinton Ave will be extended westward onto Brownlow Ave to enclose the working area. Equipment to be used will include a concrete chipper, hand tools, an excavator and concrete trucks. Concrete trucks will access the work area from the west gate at Brownlow Ave and with assistance from a traffic control person (aka flag person). Noise from concrete chipping can be expected. Work will take place within the enclosed area.

Traffic Management

Pedestrian access will be diverted south around the work zone. A traffic control person will be stationed at the work zone 24-hours a day while this work takes place to assist with pedestrian and vehicle traffic as trucks enter and exit the site. Both lanes on Brownlow Ave are expected to be maintained. The northbound right turn from Brownlow Ave onto Eglinton Ave is expected to be maintained as well. Once the work is complete, the area will be reinstated and the fence will be returned to its current location, east of Brownlow Ave.
