

Crosstown LRT Project – Update, November 4, 2019

New Traffic Configuration

As early as Wednesday November 6, a new traffic configuration will be implemented at Mount Pleasant Station.

Traffic Changes

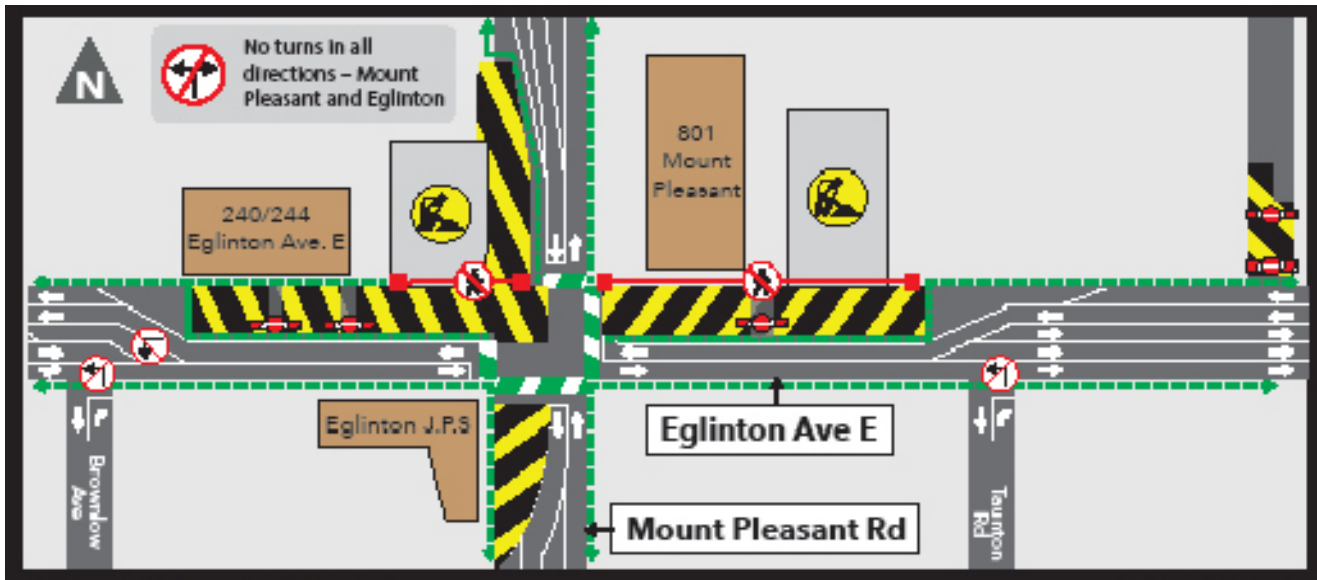
- Traffic on Mount Pleasant Road will shift to the east.
- Traffic on Eglinton Avenue East will remain on the south.
- The east-west crosswalk on the north side of Mount Pleasant Road will be partially closed.
- The west crosswalk on Eglinton Avenue East will be partially closed, and the east crosswalk will be reinstated.
- Turns in all directions at Mount Pleasant Road and Eglinton Avenue East will remain prohibited.
- The northbound left turn from Brownlow Avenue onto Eglinton Avenue East will remain prohibited.
- The northbound left turn from Taunton Road onto Eglinton Avenue East will remain prohibited.
- Rawlinson Avenue will remain closed.
- Traffic on Mount Pleasant Road will be shifted to the east side, and traffic on Eglinton Avenue East will remain on the south.

This configuration, which will be implemented during off peak hours, will be in place for approximately five months until early April 2020. During this stage, construction will return to the west side of Mount Pleasant Road, and shallow excavation and roof construction will continue. Once this stage is complete, traffic will shift to the north on Eglinton Avenue East and a new traffic stage will be implemented.

A paid-duty officer will be present while this work takes place. Access to TTC and emergency response vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Noise, lighting and traffic delays can be expected while the changes are being implemented.
