Crosstown LRT Project – Update, October 1, 2019


As early as Wednesday October 2, a new traffic configuration will be implemented at Mount Pleasant Station for approximately three weeks.

During this stage, construction will return to the north side of Eglinton Avenue, and road restoration and utilities work will continue. Once this stage is complete, traffic will shift to the east on Mt Pleasant Rd and a new traffic stage will be implemented. See below for details.

WHAT TO EXPECT NEXT WEEK

New traffic configuration at Mount Pleasant Station

- The traffic flip will begin as early as 5 a.m. and take approximately two hours to complete.
- This configuration may be in place shorter or longer than expected.
- This work may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- Access to TTC and emergency response vehicles will be maintained at all times.
- Noise, lighting and traffic delays can be expected while the changes are being implemented.



UPCOMING TRAFFIC CONFIGURATION

- Traffic on Mt Pleasant Rd. will remain on the west.
- The east crosswalk will remain closed, and the west crosswalk will be open.
- Turns in all directions at Mt Pleasant Rd. and Eglinton Ave. will remain prohibited.
- The northbound left turn from Brownlow Ave. onto Eglinton Ave. will be prohibited.
- The northbound left turn from Taunton Rd. onto Eglinton Ave. will be prohibited.
- Rawlinson Ave. will remain closed.

OTHER

As a reminder, the scaffold removal and façade restoration is underway and will take approximately eight weeks to complete.
