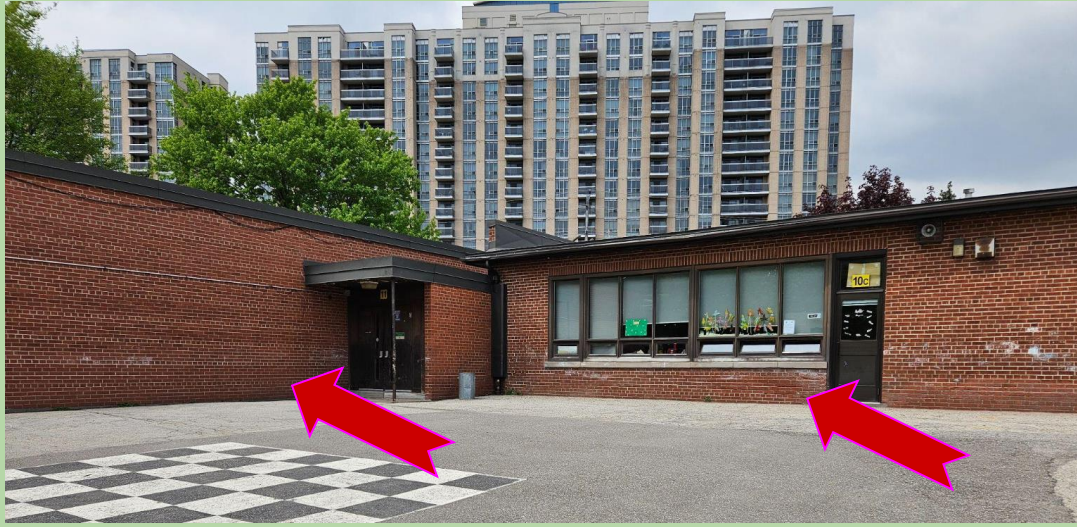


# French Immersion Kindergarten Entrances

# Pick-up



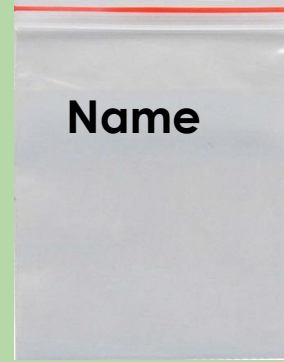
Please make sure your child's teacher knows who is going to pick up your child.

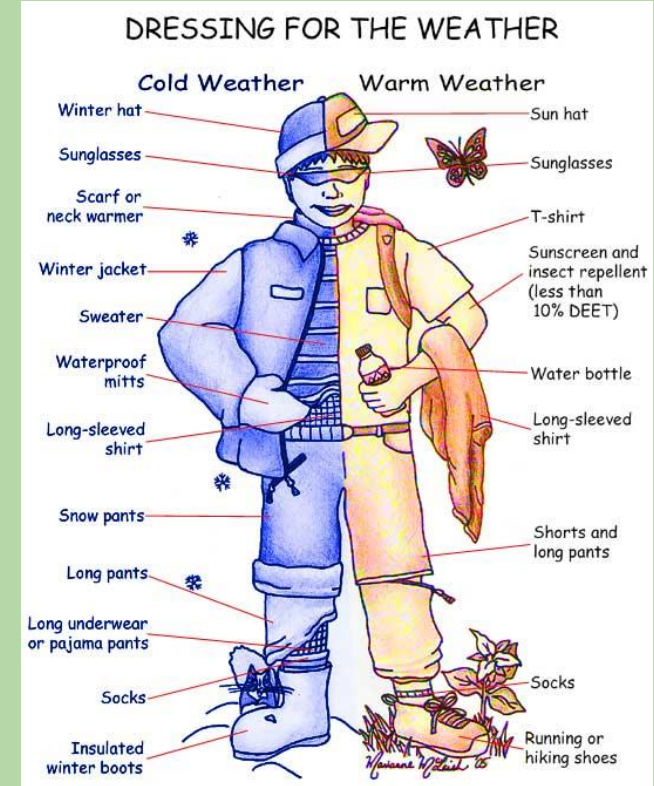

**Fresh Air & Discovery:** We use our outdoor space as an extension of the classroom.



## Kindergarten

Starting school is an exciting time for your child. Our schools provide a rich learning environment for all children to learn and grow.

In the Kindergarten program, your child will develop their skills and abilities through inquiry and intentional play-based learning. Teachers and early childhood educators plan learning experiences where children are actively engaged in learning and thinking creatively.

Children can attend Junior Kindergarten in the calendar year that they turn four and Senior Kindergarten in the year that they turn five. [Registration](#) for the **English** Kindergarten program begins in February (**\*see below for information about the Early French Immersion program**). ### **Early French Immersion (JK Entry)**

The Early French Immersion program begins in Junior Kindergarten (JK). Families who wish to have their child participate in an Early French Immersion Program **must** apply

# What is an Extended Day Program

An Extended Day Program (EDP) provide seamless learning for children from Kindergarten to Grade 6 who require care before school starts and at the end of the school day.

Children will develop skills such as collaboration, responsibility, problem-solving, creativity, citizenship and leadership through interesting activities. Extended Day Programs will be delivered by TDSB staff including a Designated Early Childhood Educator.



# Hours of Operation

## Instructional Days (Regular School Day)

The Extended Day program operates before and after the regular school day. The morning program begins at 7:15am and continues until the entry bell. Afternoon programming resumes at the school dismissal bell and operates until 6:00pm.



# Hours of Operation

- Programs are open on PA Days from 8.30am - 4:30 pm.
- Winter, March Break and Summer programs operate from 8:30am - 5:00pm
- EDPs are closed on all statutory holidays and during the last two weeks of August.

*Summer programming may be offered at a selection of TDSB school locations. EDPs will be closed for statutory holidays, one week during the Winter Break and during the last two weeks of August.*

# Extended Day Program

- Provides 2 snacks per day morning and afternoon, and our current provider is Wholesome Kids
- Parent/Guardian provides lunch on non-instructional days(PA Days, Winter Break, and March Break)



# How to Register for EDP

- Review and fill out the EDP waitlist application at your child/ren's school.
- If you are interested in learning more about TDSB Extended Day Programs, including locations, operating hours or fees, please visit TDSB EDP website for further information.
- For any EDP finance related questions please contact [EDPFinance@tdsb.on.ca](mailto:EDPFinance@tdsb.on.ca) or call 416.395.8043.
- Daily fee rate is \$41.00 on instructional Days and \$64.00 on non-instructional days ( PA DAYS, Winter Break, and March Break)
- If you require financial assistance for child care fees, you may apply for a fee subsidy through Toronto Children's Services. Please visit the City of Toronto Child Care Fee Subsidy website or contact 416-338-8888 or 311 for assistance, and advise them that you are interested in enrolling your child in the Extended Day Program (EDP).

# What Does a Day in EDP Look Like?

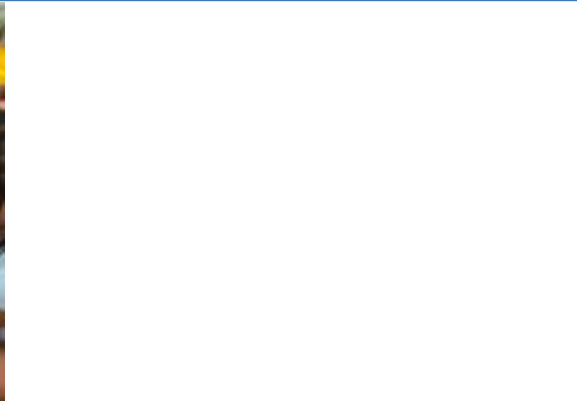
- Before school starts - Snack, activities/inquiry based set up
