Scholarships and Bursaries

Six types of scholarships available:

1. Entrance Scholarships – offered directly from the post-secondary school
2. Bursaries – offered directly from the post-secondary school, based on financial need
3. Grants – eligibility and amount set by award sponsor
4. Individually Applied Scholarships – application must be submitted
5. School Nominated Scholarships – students must let the Guidance department know they are interested in being considered for award.
6. Emery CI School Scholarships – only available to graduating Emery CI students. Students must fill out an application in the spring in order to be considered.
