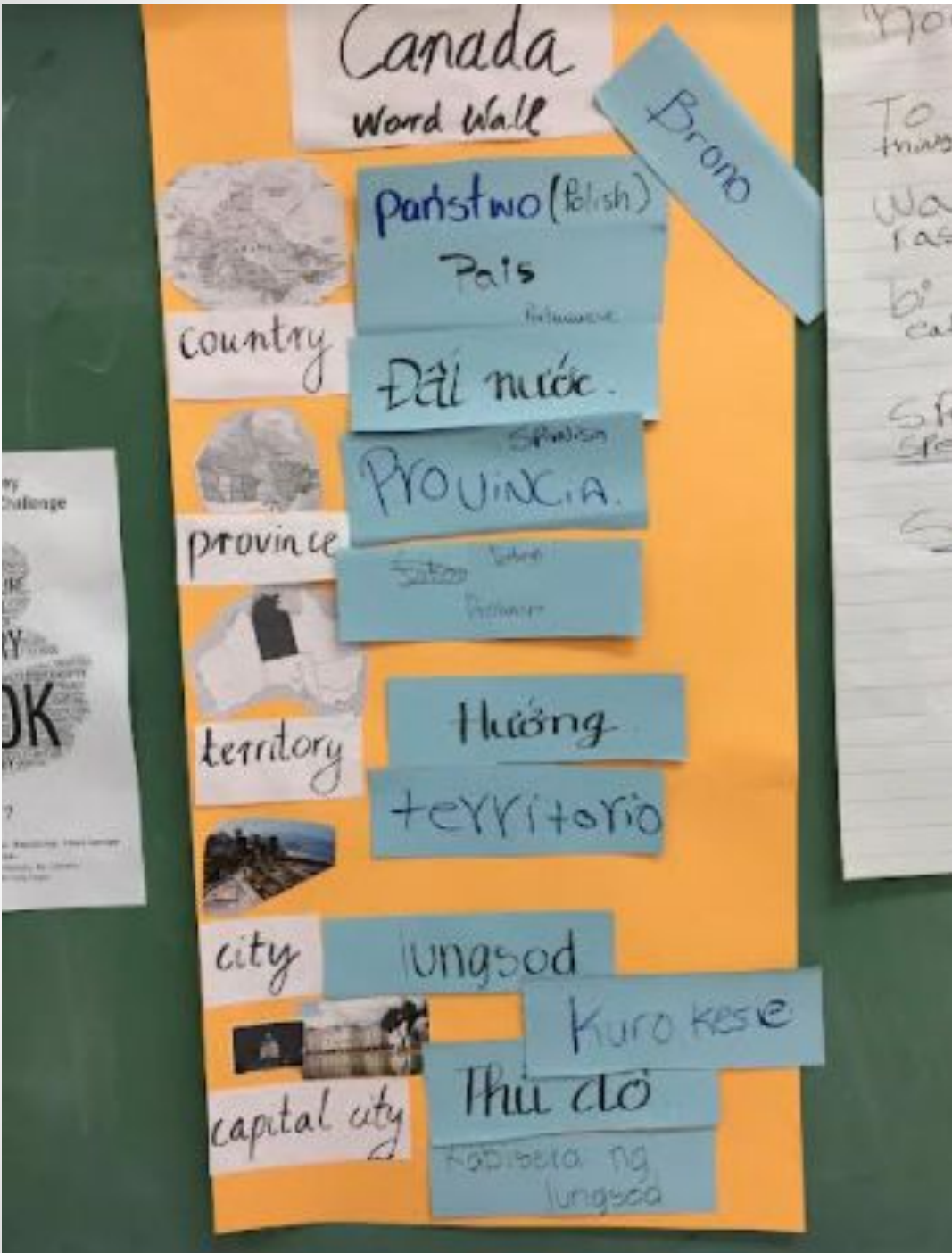
- “North York Community House” helps our newcomer families with settlement, health care, job interviews, PR card, refugee status, visa questions etc.

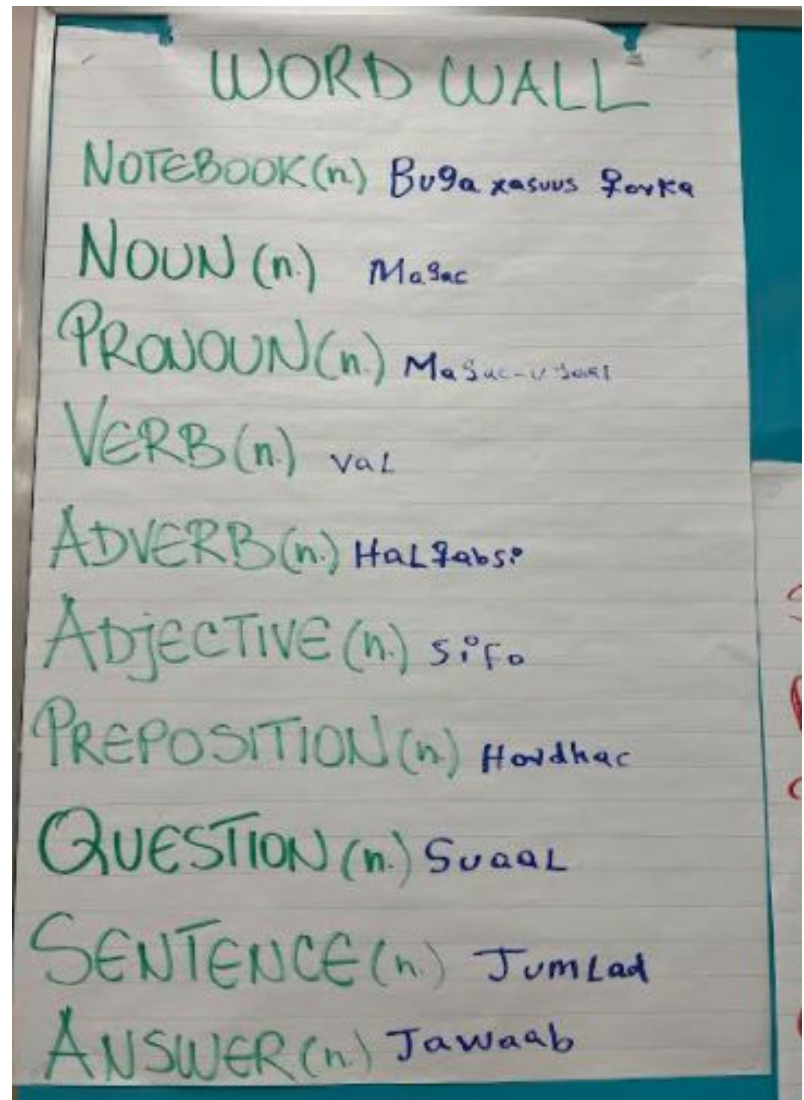
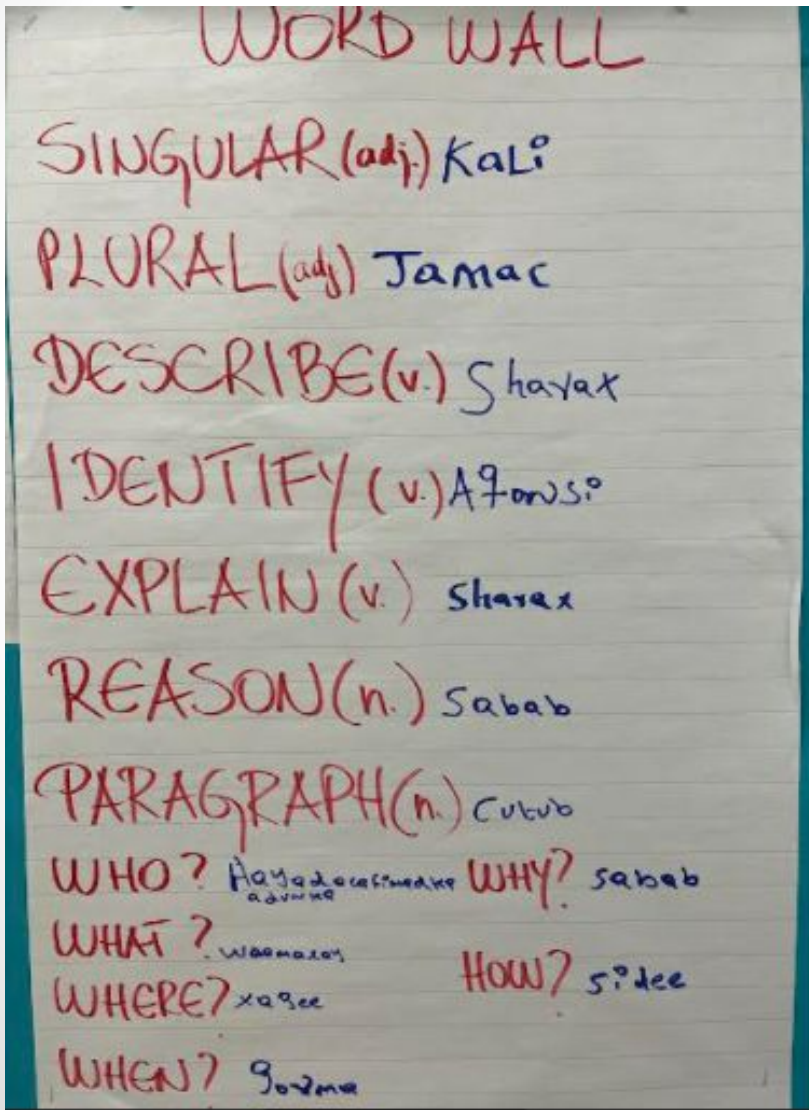
