Dear Parents,

Camp White Pine is a five-day student leadership camp that takes place in the second week of September. Any students currently enrolled in grade 9 at Etobicoke Collegiate Institute are eligible to attend as campers. This camp offers an amazing opportunity for students to improve their communication skills, creativity, confidence and other leadership skills. It often has been described as a life-changing experience by the students upon their return.

Senior students coordinate and lead the camp under the supervision of staff from both the school and the camp. There are five days of activities from dawn to dusk that will help students build positive relationships and lifelong memories.

This Student Leadership Camp runs from Monday, September 12<sup>th</sup> to Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at a cost of \$355. This will include all food, coach bus transportation and accommodations.

Payment should be done through School Cash Online. The Parent Help Desk is available to assist parents/guardians with the registration process, password recovery, accessing your account or payment issues. Families that would like to set up a payment plan can contact our vice-principal, Ms. Greeley, to discuss a payment plan.

Organizing a camp for our students involves expenditures well in advance of the camp on transportation, materials, instructors and accommodations. While we recognize that unforeseeable situations can arise that may prevent a student from attending camp, we are unable to refund the full amount of the fees after our cut-off date which is Monday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Any requests for a refund after this date will be the \$355 less \$125 for costs that cannot be recouped by the school.

We look forward to another highly valuable Student Leadership Camp experience and hope that your son/daughter will be joining us.

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### **Arrival and Departure**

Transportation to the camp will be provided.

- Senior leaders in Grade 11 and Grade 12 will depart from the ECI parking lot on Monday, September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 6:30 am.
- **Grade 10 campers** and designated Grade 11 and 12 leaders will depart from the front of ECI on Monday, September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 9:30 am.
- Students who are late for departure from the school and miss the bus will have to find their own transportation to camp. Bus fees will not be refunded.
- All students will return on buses and arrive back at ECI between 4:00pm-4:30pm on Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

#### First Aid on Site

There is a first aid station in the Infirmary building and a nurse will be available 24 hours a day during the camp. If necessary, students will be taken by staff to the nearby Haliburton hospital which is a 15 minute drive from the camp.

### **Attendance**

Students are expected to be on time and to attend and take an active part in all aspects of all sessions/programs. Sessions will proceed, rain or shine, so students should ensure that they have adequate clothing for all types of weather (see packing list).

### **Rules and Expectations**

Students are expected to be respectful, polite, considerate and co-operative with each other, the student leaders and the staff and to abide by the following rules:

- 1. Drugs and alcohol are absolutely forbidden. Prescription drugs are to be given to staff prior to departure from the school. They will be issued as prescribed by the nurse at camp. Anyone found with drugs or alcohol, or with anyone associated with the use of these substances, will be sent home at their parents' or guardian's expense. Registration fees will NOT be refunded.
- 2. Smoking, vaping and e-cigarettes are <u>not</u> permitted at anytime, anywhere during the duration of this trip.
- 3. Absolutely no nut products are to be brought to camp.
- 4. Curfew is 10:30 pm. Students are to be in their sleeping bags, in their designated cabin and silent.
- 5. No hatchets, axes, knives, guns, ammunition, bows and arrows, or other potentially dangerous objects may be brought to camp.
- 6. Boys will be accommodated in one section and the girls in another section. Boys are not allowed in girls' cabins and vice-versa.
- 7. Cell phones will not be allowed during the sessions.
- 8. Wandering from the group is not allowed and students must remain on the property unless accompanied by staff.
- 9. Visitors are not allowed. Ordering food to camp is not allowed.
- 10. It is everyone's job to keep the camp clean, pick-up any garbage and to be aware of the limitations of the septic system.




