## **Interim Markbook Reports**

Teachers will be sending home Interim Reports next week (Monday, March 5 – Thursday, March 8). A sample of the report is attached (Markbook Interim Exemplar). The reports will include marks from evaluated work to date (Entry Titles), a comment about progress or concerns and an overall standing (upper right hand corner) in the form of:

E = Excellent G = Good S = Satisfactory U = Unsatisfactory

This standing will be based partially on marks earned to date but also reflects work habits, attitude, effort and participation.

The marked work may include 2 different types of work:

**Formative assessments** as items of work that have been evaluated, recorded and returned to students but will NOT play a role in determining the final mark for a student. The information (marks) are gathered and used by teachers to monitor student progress and to help them best

respond to student needs. The formative work also provides feedback to students allowing them to monitor their own progress and make adjustments in their learning approaches. **Summative assessments** are marked based on established criteria and reflect the quality of student learning. It is these marks that will be used to determine final marks in courses.

Hard copies of any "Unsatisfactory" reports will also be mailed home before the March Break to ensure that they reach parents/guardians.
