Students should bring a refillable water bottle and dress for the weather as we will be outside.

Student Activity Package

All students are expected to purchase a Student Activity package for \$60. This money supports a variety of initiatives in the school (please see Opening Day attachment for exact breakdown). Additionally, grade 9 students receive a free Dudley lock for their locker.
