FHCI - Daily COVID Screening

Before coming to school each day, all students and staff must conduct an active <u>health screening self-assessment</u>. If answering yes to any of these questions, staff and students should stay home; self-isolate right away; and call Telehealth or your health care provider to find out if you need to be tested. For more information about testing, please visit <u>www.toronto.ca/home/covid-19/</u> If answering **no** to all of these questions, please record the information <u>daily</u> in one of the following ways, which will allow your student to enter to the school.

- 1. PREFERRED METHOD "Now Mobile" app (attached instructions)
- Each day, students are to log in, complete the screening questions.
- Through the app, a QR code is generated.
- Students can either show the QR code from the app, a screenshot of the daily QR code or have a printout of the QR code.
- This method allows us to process students in approximately 10 seconds.
- 2. If not using the Now Mobile app, students can bring a signed copy of the <u>Student Health Pass</u>.
- Please make sure that the form is dated and signed each day after self screening and please ensure that the student's first and last name are clearly printed (in large letters) on the sheet.
- The same sheet can be used for four weeks of classes.
- This method allows us to process students in approximately 30 seconds.
- 3. If the QR code or Student Health Pass are not brought, staff will have to go through the fourteen screening questions with each student and manually record them.
- This method requires more than 60 seconds for each student.
- This will take the longest amount of time and will likely cause some delays to entry.

Students will then sanitize their hands and continue to their classroom. Your support in expediting the entry process is appreciated.
