Registration opens at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, January 7, 2019 and closes at 2:00pm on January 30. Registration is online. Log on using your student number and your computer network password. Signed parent/guardian consent forms which will be emailed to you upon registration must be returned to your guidance counsellor before the registration can be approved. A list of course offerings and school locations can be found on the website or in the guidance office.

Please note:

- Students may not register for a night school course if that course is available at FHCI and has already been scheduled or can be scheduled second semester.
- No approvals will be given for TCDSB night school courses if the same course is offered at a TDSB night school.

Explore is a 5-week **intensive French language summer immersion program** (ages 16+) or 3-week program (ages 13-15) adapted to your level. You must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident to apply. Participants in the program receive a bursary that covers tuition fees, instructional materials, meals and accommodations, workshops and other mandatory activities. Bursaries are awarded by random draw. Since it is considered taxable income, you will need to have a Social Insurance Number (SIN). Priority is given to first-time applicants and every effort is made to place you at one of the participating colleges and universities across Canada that you have chosen. Visit the website for the latest information, a list of participating post-secondary institutions, and to apply online. The **early-bird deadline** to apply is **February 15, 2019.**
