

There are still some college and university visits in November; see below.

Nov 21 Full Disclosure Date. If you drop your course before this date, the course will not show up on your transcript. After that date, the course and the mark you had when you dropped it will appear on your transcript. Don't wait until the 21st; you won't have time to complete the form in one day.

Dick Martin Scholarship Award (Occupational Health & Safety or OHS)

Criteria:

- Must be enrolled in an occupational health & safety-related course or program at an accredited Canadian college or university leading to a certificate, diploma, or degree in OHS.
- Write 1,000-1,200 word essay on ONE of the following:
 - Prevention Essay: Choose a high risk workplace hazard. How would you work to solve and create awareness about the issue?
 - Technical Essay: Research an existing or emerging hazard or risk (coverage may include how to identify, assess and control the risks).
