Please remember to keep our students safe by following some basic traffic rules:

Please **do not park on** the East side of the street as it blocks the ability for cars not stopping to move along the road. -Hawarden becomes a one way street going West at the beginning and end of each day to allow the Forest Hill students who arrive via bus to safely be dropped-off and picked-up. Please do not go East along Hawarden at these times. -Do not stop or park in the bus loading zones on Hawarden. When cars are parked illegally, the buses have difficulty turning the corner. The buses then stop the traffic and make it very dangerous for our students who use the school buses. -As a courtesy to our neighbours, please do not block the ends of their drivewavs. We will be monitoring these areas closely and Enforcement Officers from Toronto Police will be
