Data Management- (continued)

- Read, construct and analyze various graphs (bar, picto and line graph)

Measurement

- Measure objects using non-standard and standard units of measurement (cubes vs ruler)

Reading

- Read and use various comprehension strategies (e.g., Visualization/Predictions) to demonstrate an understanding of a variety of texts

Writing

- Letter Writing-students will be learning features of letter writing and use them to write various types of letters (e.g., a letter to a friend, a letter to the principal)

Oral Communication

- demonstrate an understanding of information and ideas in oral texts by retelling or restating the story

Media Literacy:

- Identify some media forms and explain how the conventions and techniques associated with them are used to create meaning (e.g., features of a poster/advertisement)
