Reading

Writing

- Procedural Writing-students will be learning how to write various types of procedures (e.g., how to brush your teeth, how to play a game, how to bake a cake)

Oral Communication

- demonstrate an understanding of appropriate listening behaviour by using active listening strategies in a variety of situations
