Pre Visit Activities

- begin a Know, Wonder, Learn (KWL) chart about jobs that take care of the environment to bring with you to Forest Valley
- take a community walk to look for evidence of people engaged in jobs related to the environment
- do a survey to find out what types of jobs are most common among the families represented in your class
- as a class, identify an environmental challenge that impacts your immediate community and research who might help you solve that problem (e.g. garbage in a local ravine or park, not enough trees or wildlife in your playground)
- ask your Eco Schools committee for help
- make a map of the trees on your school property

Post Visit Activities

- take a community walk to look for evidence of people engaged in jobs related to the environment
- do a survey to find out what types of jobs are most common among the families represented in your class
- as a class, identify an environmental challenge that impacts your immediate community and research who might help you solve that problem (e.g. garbage in a local ravine or park, not enough trees or wildlife in your playground)
- ask your Eco Schools committee for help
