## **Pre Visit Activities**

- Using images of homes from around the world, formulate questions about how people meet their basic human needs
- Record what students already know and what they wonder about in a KWL chart and bring it with you to Forest Valley
- Use or make a local community map to gather and organize information for how people meet their needs in your local community
- Begin comparing how we meet our needs here in Toronto with another part of the world
- Review how people adapt to the changing seasons in different parts of the world and determine which countries have similar climate based on how people meet their needs

## **Post Visit Activities**

- Compare how students adapted to the Forest Valley Environment to meet their needs with how they meet their needs at home
- Communicate the results of their inquiry and consider as a class how they might act locally while thinking globally (e.g. Eco Schools waste reduction campaign, Me to We campaign)
