News You Can Use

Today is **Orange Shirt Day and the National Day of Truth and Reconciliation.** Marked annually, this day honours survivors of the residential school system, remembers those who did not survive, and recognizes the ongoing effects of intergenerational trauma.

Did you know that Indigenous children and families still face ongoing systemic racism, discrimination, and inequity in Canada? The federal government falls short in providing basic public services for First Nations, Metis and Inuit children and families. Canada has repeatedly chosen to normalize inequity between Indigenous and non-Indigenous children rather than fix the problem. There is no clean drinking water in 1 in 6 First Nations communities. Foster care has been called a modern-day residential school system, with more Indigenous family separations happening now than at the height of the residential school system. Honour Orange Shirt Day this year by recognizing the continued injustices faced by Indigenous children and families in Canada.
