		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Achievement Literacy: Increase literacy achievement on the report cards of all students to the provincial standard and close disproportionate outcomes - Achievement Mathematics: Increase math achievement on the report cards of all students to provincial standard and close disproportionate outcomes - Thrive: Improve % of students who believe their learning has prepared them for the next step in their learning experience (i.e., next grade) - Belong: Increase the % of students in Grades 1-8, whose individual attendance rate is equal to or greater than 90% - Pedagogical documentation updated throughout the year on SIP bulletin board in front foyer and updates sharing in school newsletter; highlights shared in meeting - Community officer presentations in April (had been a request at last School Council meeting) - Kindergarten teams are deciding whether they are doing a spring concert and/or celebration of learning – may do in their classrooms, in the gym or perhaps outside like a teddy bear picnic - Grade 8 students voted on what they wanted for their grad dinner — pizza was selected - Students also voted to do trivia, games and dance at the grad event; Suzie said they did not want a photo booth - SATEC for the ceremony and then students come back to the school for dinner and games/trivia/dance
