School Updates</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Very few families completed the start of year forms online - had been re-sent digitally and printed out and sent home with students. - Still missing a significant number, as well as medical information forms not completed - Going to be mailing all families the volunteer information, so we can be proactive in starting the paperwork and going to include the start of year forms that have not been returned and/or medical forms - Continue to support School Improvement - updating SIP board in front foyer - Sending primary, junior and intermediate students to system math PD to build collective capacity - Supporting Grade 8 to 9 transition - students are beginning to find out if they have been accepted to specialised programs in high school
