4. Principal Report – Shirley Ponka

- Thank you for gift of a holiday treat for our staff, it was enjoyed!
- Students and staff happy to be back to routine- attention to attendance, punctuality and warm layers
 - There is a need for back-up garments: Snow pants, socks, mittens donations welcome
- All adjusting to cold weather, thanks to council for contributions of shovels and snow moulds
- Welcoming an influx of new students to our school
- School Improvement Team (SIP) focussed on our three goals:

 - Jenny Gloria moved to approve the use of council funds to purchase 5 chrome books. Unanimous approval
- Learning Opportunities Index (LOI): GP Mackie ranks #247 (out of 471)
 - The LOI ranks each school based on measures of external challenges affecting student success. The school with the greatest level of external challenges is ranked number one and is described as highest on the index. It is important to

acknowledge that students in all schools have some external challenges, even those schools that are ranked very low on the LOI. The LOI measures relative need and compares all schools on exactly the same set of data collected in a consistent, reliable, and objective manner.
