Treasurer Update

- \$961 carried over from last year
- Every year we receive an allocation, \$323 was provided to us for this year
- \$500 provided for parent engagement funds
- Total starting the school year \$1,748.41

Principals Report

- Demographics
  - Projected at 258 students this year, as of today we have 251
  - o Language
    - We still have enough students for a half time ESL teacher
  - Special Education/Learning Needs
    - Noticed an increase of students with special needs, working creatively with current Human Resources to support
- Staffing
  - Ms. Sorgo, will be going on mat leave, Ms. Sierra will be bridging gap any time she is away until then and the role will be posted for a full time replacement (for which Ms Sierra can apply)
  - Ms. Casey was hired on full time for Grade 3
- Facilities
  - Portable 5 has arrived, waiting on the inspector to come
  - Path on the side will be widened
  - Playground enhancements will be taking place, meeting in the fall, council members will be invited
    - \$15,000 of donations have been put aside from past years
    - Accessibility will be considered in the new plan
- Safe Schools
  - Covid going around again
  - 2 lice check letters have been sent home but staff was quickly able to get lice checks done, was found to not be spreading
- Teaching & Learning
  - New screening tool for reading, teachers are being trained how to use the tool (Kindergarten to grade 2)

- Believe the screening tool results will be provided in Progress Report, perhaps Term 1 (February); more info coming

  - Outdoor Play & Learning, eventually @ Recess (starting small and building)
