SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship for Indigenous Students

All Aboriginal children can apply for this scholarship. Applicants must complete an application form and a 750-1000 word essay. Students can win a \$1500.00 scholarship. Visit www.nupge.ca for details. **Last year's deadline: July 07, 2020**

The Ade Adegbite Memorial Scholarship: To Assist Students with Epilepsy

Two scholarships of \$1500 each are awarded annually. You must have epilepsy, be 17 years of age, and be a Canadian Citizen or a permanent resident to qualify. **Deadline: To be set**

Allan Simpson Educational Fund Awards

Scholarships of \$2500 are awarded to assist with the costs of post-secondary education for young people who are full orphans (both parents deceased). **Deadline: March 1st annually**

Brian Fudge Memorial Scholarship

George S. Henry can submit one male and one female athlete who have demonstrated outstanding commitment to sport. You must receive a nomination from your coach to be eligible for the award. **Last year's deadline: June 1, 2020**

Each winner receives a certificate and a cash award of \$2 500. **Deadline: May 31 annually**

The Merit Award Bursary is for any grade 12 Student that will be attending a university or college program in the following school year. To be considered, students must show a dedication to school work, a high level of commitment to extracurricular school activities, and a high level of commitment to volunteerism in the community at large. **Deadline: To be set**

Mon Sheong Foundation Golden Jubilee Awards of Excellence

The Mon Sheong Foundation, Ontario's first Chinese-Canadian voluntary charitable organization, is offering 10 awards, worth up to \$1,000. OFSAA Alumni Scholarships

Four OFSAA Alumni Scholarships are presented annually to two graduating girls and two boys who will enroll in a postsecondary institution in September. Criteria for selection include participation in high school sport, involvement in extracurricular and community activities, and an academic average of at least 80%. **Deadline: April 15, 2020 (it was extended to May 20th last year)**

The Ontario Medal for Young Volunteers

For students who have demonstrated exceptional leadership in volunteering in the community.
Last year's deadline: January 15, Annually

Ontario Trucking Association Scholarship

In order to win this scholarship, applicants must write a short essay that answers a question about Ontario's trucking industry. You must also have at least one parent that is employed or contracted to an Ontario trucking or trucking-related service. The scholarship is valued at \$1500.

Deadline: January 15, 2021

PACE Credit Union Bursaries

Queen's University Entrance Scholarships

Each scholarship includes full tuition, plus \$3,500 a year towards living expenses and a guaranteed offer of summer employment from TD Canada Trust. **Deadline: November 13, 2020**

Terry Fox Humanitarian Award Program

This award program recognizes the benevolence of young Canadians and encourages them to continue their humanitarian works while attending college or university in Canada.

Deadline: To be set

Tommy Douglas Scholarship

This scholarship is available for any student entering a public post-secondary institution. Students must complete a 750-1000 word essay outline how Tommy Douglas' life contributed to making Canada a more just and equitable society. The scholarship is for \$1500.00. Visit www.nupge.ca for details. **Last year's deadline: July 6, 2020**

Toronto Real Estate Board Scholarship

Two scholarships are available to graduating students who are going to pursue a post-secondary education. Applicants must have a record of academic achievement and possess a range of leadership qualities and community involvement. **Deadline: To be set (application is available in February 2021)**

Union Plus Scholarship

This scholarship is open to all graduating students. Students are judged on their academic ability, social awareness, financial need, and appreciation of labour. The scholarship is valued at \$4000.00. **Deadline: January 31, 2021**

University of Guelph President's Scholarships/Lincoln Alexander Chancellor's Scholarships

Graduating students applying to Guelph with a minimum 85% average and who hold positions of leadership in school or in the community are encouraged to pick up an application form. Henry is permitted to nominate one student for each of these scholarships.

Deadline: January annually

University of Ottawa's Faculty of Science Scholarships

An \$8,000 Research Scholarship is offered by the Faculty of Science at the University of Ottawa to provide new students with first-rate scientific experience. Applications may be downloaded from www.science.uottawa.ca. **Deadline: To be set**

University of Toronto National Book Awards

Henry can choose one outstanding student on the basis of their academic pursuits, enthusiasm for intellectual exploration, and their involvement in school life and community. The student that is selected can then enter the National Scholarship Competition. You don't have to attend U of T to win. Speak to a guidance counsellor if you would like to be considered. **Deadline: October 15, 2020**

Western University Ontario Entrance Scholarships

Henry is permitted to nominate three students for these scholarships, which are designed to reward all-around excellence, both in academics and extra-curricular achievement.

Deadline: To be set

Wolfe Family Entrance Scholarship

This scholarship recognizes academic excellence, volunteerism, and participation in sports and physical fitness. The scholarship is valued at \$6000 and is renewable for up to 3 years.

Last Year's Deadline: May 1, 2021

YWCA Women of Distinction Award

This award is for a young woman who volunteers her time to help other women or girls, or is a role model to her peers. **Last Year's Deadline: January 7, 2019**
