SCHOLARSHIPS

Ade Adegbite Memorial Scholarship: To Assist Students with Epilepsy

Two scholarships of \$1500 each are awarded annually. You must have epilepsy, be 17 years of age, and be a Canadian Citizen or a permanent resident to qualify. **Deadline: Announced in Spring 2025.**

Allan Simpson Educational Fund Awards

Scholarships of \$2500 are awarded to assist with the costs of post-secondary education for young people who are full orphans (both parents deceased). **Deadline: March 1st annually.**

Belairdirect Scholarship

\$1000.00 scholarships are available. **Available in spring 2025.**

This scholarship is for students entering the field of policing, criminal justice services, community services or healthcare. You must be the child/grandchild of a National Union of Public and General Employees Member. **Last year's deadline: August 1, 2024**

Brian Maxwell Memorial Scholarship

George S. Henry can submit one male and one female athlete who have demonstrated outstanding commitment to sport. You must receive a nomination from your coach to be eligible for the award. **Deadline: June 9, 2025.**

Building Brighter Futures Bursaries and Scholarships

This scholarship is available for First Nations, Metis, and Inuit students. The value of the scholarships varies. **Deadlines Vary**

Herbert Carnegie Future Aces Foundation Scholarship

Herbert Carnegie was born in Toronto in 1919 following the emigration of his parents from Jamaica. Mr. Carnegie's vision of justice and equity of opportunity has led to the creation of scholarships promoting this philosophy. Henry may nominate two deserving students for these \$1,000 awards. The most important criteria for graduating students are exemplary citizenship qualities and financial need. James Bartleman Indigenous Youth Creative Writing Award

Each year this program recognizes Indigenous students for their creative writing talent. Creative pieces may include, but are not limited to short stories, poems, essays, plays, or songs. All submissions must be original work created by the student. The award has three categories: fly-in community, on-reserve and off-reserve. Each winner receives a certificate and a cash award of \$2 500.

Deadline: May 31 annually.

Jean Lumb Awards: Students of Chinese Heritage

The Jean Lumb Awards are available to students of Chinese heritage. There are four categories of awards: academics, athletics, arts and community service. Applicants are available online at www.jeanlumbfoundation.ca. **Last year's deadline: May 20, 2024.**

Lee Awards

The awards range from \$150 to \$500. To apply, students must be of Canadian Indigenous ancestry (Status and Non-Status, Metis, or Inuit), attending high school, and living in the GTA. Visit www.mbdca.ca. **Last year's Deadline: May 31, 2024.**

Leon C. Bynoe Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship awards approximately \$1300.00 to a student with financial need and outstanding academic achievement. Preference is given to candidates from the Afro-Canadian community and Metro Toronto Housing Authority residents who have demonstrated outstanding service to the Afro-Canadian community. **Deadline: November 1, 2024.**

Dr. Lila Fahlman Scholarship

This scholarship is designed to help a Muslim woman, who demonstrates consistent academic performance and leadership skills. Amount: \$500.00. **Deadline: To be set.**

The Loran Award

Winners of this award receive \$10 000 annually, summer internships, and are matched with a trusted mentor. Visit www.loranscholar.ca for more information. George S. Henry Academy can sponsor up to three students, although students that are not sponsored can still apply. **Deadline: October 15, 2024.**

Merit Award Bursary

The Merit Award Bursary is for any grade 12 Student that will be attending a university or college program in the following school year. To be considered, students must show a dedication to schoolwork, a high level of commitment to extracurricular school activities, and a high level of commitment to volunteerism in the community at large. **Last year's deadline: March 25, 2024.**

Mon Sheong Foundation Golden Jubilee Awards of Excellence

The Mon Sheong Foundation, Ontario's first Chinese Canadian voluntary charitable organization, is offering 10 awards, worth up to \$1,000. These awards are open to all secondary students, "regardless of sex, religious belief and ethnic background." Visit their web site at www.monsheong.org for more details. Nupge Scholarships for Indigenous Students

All Indigenous students can apply for this scholarship. Applicants must complete an application form. Students can win a \$1500.00 scholarship. Visit www.nupge.ca for details. **Last year's deadline: August 1, 2024.**

OFSAA Alumni Scholarships

Four OFSAA Alumni Scholarships are presented annually to two graduating girls and two boys who will enroll in a postsecondary institution in September. Criteria for selection include participation in high school sport, involvement in extracurricular and community activities, and an academic average of at least 80%. **Deadline: April 1, 2025.**

The Ontario Medal for Young Volunteers

For students who have demonstrated exceptional leadership in volunteering in the community.

Last year's deadline: January 15, Annually.

Ontario Trucking Association Scholarship

In order to win this scholarship, applicants must write a short essay that answers a question about Ontario's trucking industry. You must also have at least one parent that is employed or contracted to an Ontario trucking or trucking-related service. The scholarship is valued at \$1500.

Applications available in April.

Queen's University Entrance Scholarships

Applicants to Queen's major entrance scholarships are available in the Guidance Office. Henry nominates a single student for the Chancellor's Scholarship, but the other scholarships do not require school nominations. **Deadline: To be set.**

RBC Royal Bank Scholarships

To be considered for this scholarship, you must submit a Resume to Mr. Mindenhall before January 17th, 2024 **Deadline: January 29, 2025 (Nomination Deadline).**

Each scholarship includes full tuition, plus \$3,500 a year towards living expenses and a guaranteed offer of summer employment from TD Canada Trust. **Deadline: November 13, 2024.**

Terry Fox Humanitarian Award Program

This award program recognizes the benevolence of young Canadians and encourages them to continue their humanitarian works while attending college or university in Canada. **Deadline: See website for details.**

Tommy Douglas Scholarship

This scholarship is available for any student entering a public post-secondary institution. Students must complete a 750-1000 word essay outline how Tommy Douglas' life contributed to making Canada a more just and equitable society. The scholarship is for \$1500.00. Toronto Real Estate Board Scholarship

Two scholarships are available to graduating students who are going to pursue a post-secondary education. Applicants must have a record of academic achievement and possess a range of leadership qualities and community involvement. **Deadline: To be set**

Union Plus Scholarship

This scholarship is open to all graduating students. Students are judged on their academic ability, social awareness, financial need, and appreciation of labour. The scholarship is valued at \$4000.00. **Last year's deadline: January 31, 2025.**

The student that is selected can then enter the National Scholarship Competition. You don't have to attend U of T to win. Speak to a guidance counsellor if you would like to be considered. **Deadline: October 4, 2024 to submit resume to Student Services.**
