Here are some key messages for this week. Do read this message until the end as there is important information regarding your children.

### **NEW!! Bikes and Scooters on Property**

Parents and Guardians need to dismount from bikes or scooters when on school property. Fast riders have caught our students and families off guard, and we need to avoid accidents. Thank you for understanding and working together.

### **NEW!! – Student Medication**

As Thursday June 25, 2026 is the last day of school for students, we will be sending home all student medication on this day. We will also send home the TDSB Administration of Prescribed Medication form to be taken to the doctor over the summer break. Please bring all student medication and the signed doctor's form back on

the September 8th, the first day of school. This way we are prepared in case of an emergency.

### **NEW!! – Report Cards and Last Day for Student Learning**

Report Cards will be coming home to families on Wednesday June 24<sup>th</sup> and the last day of school will be Thursday June 25<sup>th</sup>.

### **NEW!! - Professional Activity Day – June 26**

On June 26, 2026, the Ministry of Education has outlined this day as a mandatory PA day. **There is no school for students on this day.** The topics staff will be covering are: Tackling Racism and Artificial Intelligence. Thank you for your ongoing support as we work together to create safe, inclusive, and engaging learning environments where every student can belong, achieve, and thrive.

### **NEW!! - End of School and Summer School Closure**

As the end of school approaches, students are reminded to bring home all items. The school will be closed from Monday June 29<sup>th</sup> to Monday August 24<sup>th</sup> with no access to the building to retrieve items. During this time, our custodial staff will be conducting a deep clean on all learning areas as well as waxing floors. Thank you for understanding.

### **NEW!! – Student Classes for September 2026**

Families will be notified Friday September 4<sup>th</sup> of their child's homeroom class and teacher. We are accepting new registrations and there are changes. If you know your family is moving or if your child will be attending another school in September, please let the office know.

### **Monitoring of Student Social Media Use**

In the past weeks, we have had concerns emerge from the unmonitored use of social media in the evenings and weekends. Do supervise your children online and monitor their

conversations as these issues are overflowing into the instructional day and impacting their learning. At school, students do not use devices for social media purposes. Cell phones are turned off and put away.

If you know your child is moving to another school in September, please let our office know. We are in the midst of planning for our 2026-2027 school year and need to finalize our student numbers.

### **September 2026 Class Placements**

As we are preparing for the upcoming 2026-2027 school year, we are building our classes. There are many learning needs and dynamics we consider to appropriately balance the classes. We will try to accommodate placement requests; however, at times, we may be unable to guarantee all placement requests. Students and families will know their teacher in September as there are still adjustments as new students register. Thank you for your continued support and understanding.

### **George Syme Code of Conduct**

As a school, we are focusing on our school-wide code of conduct. Teachers are reviewing it in classrooms and students are reviewing it in circle times. ### **Second Floor Reminder**

Parents and guardians are welcome at George Syme Community School! When you arrive, please start your visit to the office. If you need to drop something off for your child, do let a secretary know and she will contact the classroom teacher, and an arrangement will be made for the item to be delivered. If you need to visit your child's classroom due to a pre-arranged visit, do check in at the office and you will be given a visitor's badge. For everyone's safety, do not walk throughout the school, especially the second floor without first visiting the office.

### **Attendance**

Families are being asked to use the safe arrival system to phone their child's absence in daily when they are away. This information will go directly to our office staff and to teachers. **The number for safe arrival is 1-833-250-2290. Or you may call George Syme at 416-394-2340 and choose option 1 to report an absence.**

### **Start-Up Forms**

#### **Student Cellphones**

When at school **students must turn their cellphones off and they**

**need to be put away in their backpack.** They are not to be used in washrooms or during recess times. Students will be reminded, and, if needed, teachers will contact parents.

### **Medication**

If your child has any medication to take during the day, be sure to fill out the medical form, take the form to your doctor and meet with your child's teacher. For those who came to school last year, student medication and doctor forms were sent home on the last day of school. Be sure to check their expiry date and bring them back to the office right away. Designated staff are unable to administer any medication without a form signed by a doctor. Students must **always keep their medication on them and not in their backpack. A waist-pouch is an easy way to facilitate this.**

### **Cash online**

### **Important - Parking Lot Safety**

Please remember to avoid walking through the parking lot. We are asking that you use the walkways on school property to get to the sidewalks. This is for safety! It is **difficult for drivers to see small children when backing out of parking spaces.** Pass this message to childcare providers, babysitters, or anyone else who is dropping off or picking up your children.
