Principal's Update with Dan Taylor

- We have had a fantastic opening month to the school year with an amazing turn out to school curriculum night/BBQ and grades 5 and 6 students at the Island School overnight.
- Superintendent Mike Gallagher came to visit on October 10th he has been in communication with the planning department and will look to start the process soon regarding the grade configuration for Givins/Shaw. The process should be completed prior to the December break. Council will be informed of any subsequent meetings.
- Superintendent Gallagher was quite impressed with our school improvement planning thus far – staff created a list of all the factors that would be required in order for Givins/Shaw students to be successful – we then took all those points and as a staff, determined if the points best fit into the category of Equity, Well-being or Achievement. Each staff member is on one of those three committees and each committee then selected two or three of the points to focus on for the 2017/18 school year. The committees are to examine what they would require with regards to budget, other resources, how to measure impact/effectiveness, etc., committees are now finalizing their plans and are to submit them to me by the end of the week (Oct 20th).

c) Technology Update

 Our Wi-Fi is working better this year with more regular consistency, and we are scheduled to be upgraded in December 2017



- Technology plan continues to be implemented every teacher and ECE now has an iPad. The Kindergarten team met Oct 17th to examine how to best use Google Keep as a means of pedagogical documentation vs. other classroom software implementations (such as Seesaw)
- Apple has delayed shipment of the 12 Apple TV boxes so we are still waiting to incorporate these into the classrooms
- We are asking Council to consider committing to the purchase of 2 more sets of 10 iPads (20 in total) – this would allow all of our Junior classes to be outfitted. The additional expense to Council would be approximately \$10,000
