### f. Treasurer's Report

Hanny provided an update and a good reference to consider – typically we raise approx. \$29,000 per year and we spend about the same. This past year was an anomaly due to COVID, where we raised \$25,000 less than we typically would. We also spent \$12,000 less than we typically would. So if people need a reason to open their wallets, it's because we are \$12,000 behind where we would normally be due to cancellation of the Fun Fair/Parent Band Night/etc. Bottom line – fundraising is still important and we need to continue to think of opportunities to raise money for our school.

These are the main points covered by Principal Taylor during the meeting:

- Please inform us via email regarding absenteeism, and include reason for absence
- The HVAC construction has almost concluded
- Please keep a child at home until they are free of symptoms for 24 hours
- We ordered new digital resources, K to 6, for both language and math to which we should have access soon have
- We would be neglectful in our duties if we weren't considering the possibility of going remote at a moment's notice, so we are incorporating that into our planning
- Any decision to take a classroom outside for parts of the day is the teacher's decision And we
  have been making great use of our outdoor spaces
- the on-line platforms (google classroom) of the teachers will likely be Launched soon if they are
  not already. Teachers will be in contact with their families soon in order to discuss how to use the
  platform and to introduce the new resources and how to access them
- There is a strong potential re-organization will be coming next week and classes may have to be changed again
