

School Improvement Planning @ Halbert

Literacy @ Halbert



This year our school will focus on small group instruction, specifically in Literacy. You will continue to hear phrases like "shared reading," "modelled reading," "guided reading" or "independent reading" from your children and teachers.

In our Early Years (K - 2) we are focussing on helping our students learn letter sounds and how these sounds form words when we string them together. By knowing sounds children will be better able to decode unfamiliar words during any of the different reading lesson throughout the day.

Literacy @ Halbert



In our Primary and Junior divisions our teachers focus on making deep connections with the texts they are reading. Students are expected to make links to other texts they have read or to real life situations.

Students, in the Junior division, are asked to think more critically about what they read and express their opinions on the issues presented by the text.

Levelled Text - What are they?



As students become proficient readers their ability to decode words and reading stamina increases. Teachers use levelled texts as a way to gradually build independence.

Texts are levelled or grouped according to difficulty. The level of difficulty could be based on words with larger numbers of syllables, content of the text or complexity of vocabulary and sentence structure.

Why use levelled texts?



A Russian psychologist named Lev Vygotsky taught educators that if you want your students to advance, you must provide instruction slightly above their current skill level. He referred to this as **The Zone of Proximal Development**. By providing instruction that is slightly challenging, students can learn new skills and apply them to different situations.

By using levelled texts, teachers can meet the students at their current reading level and provide instruction to scaffold their learning to develop their stamina, fluency and comprehension.




