Together we raise awareness and learn about leadership.




Building a welcoming community is crucial and beginning with celebrating identities is a great place to start!

Students in 16B using different skin tone paints to create an amazing bulletin board!




All forms of writing is for a specific purpose and audience. Students in Ms. Prince's class are exploring *writing to entertain* through writing postcards!


Primary Playground Updates



New Playscape


The TDSB has approved the refresh of our playscape. The image opposite indicates the extent of the Board funded refresh!

Our goal is create the sensory garden and natural play area on the right side of the new playground.




Fundraising Updates
