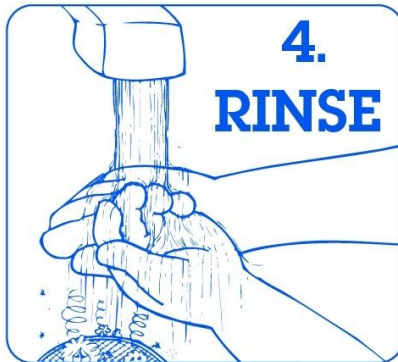
Jungle Sport is coming to Halbert!
