

Hello Harbord parents/guardians and students:

I hope everyone is well and healthy. As was announced by the TDSB and the Ministry, we will continue with remote learning on Monday April 19 (Day 2) until further notice. Although we will be learning from home, your child will be following the same schedule/timetable for their academic programming as was the case before the April break (your child's teachers may communicate with you to provide any further details). As always, attendance will be taken for each class (synchronous and asynchronous), and students are expected to be logged on during the scheduled times for their planned programming. I will continue to provide updates to our school community as the information becomes available next week regarding Quadmester 4 learning structure and schedule.

Credit Rescue Days:

The last day of instruction for most classes in Quadmester 3 is Tuesday, April 20 (Day 3). If there are any students who are in need of completing any work/project/assignment to pass their course and earn their credit, these students will have that opportunity on our Credit Rescue Days on:

- Wednesday, April 21 from 12:30pm to 1:45pm (depending on the course/teacher, there may be classes in the morning) - Course 1 is 12:30pm to 1:45pm and Course 2 is 2:00pm to 3:15pm.
- Thursday, April 22 from 8:45am to 12:30pm – Course 1 is 8:45am to 10:30am and Course 2 is 10:45am to 12:30pm.

Again, this work will be done virtually at home with their teachers. Keep up the hard work Tigers!
