We want all students to have a safe and enjoyable time while at Semi. No student should be in possession of, or under the influence of, drugs or alcohol. This includes vaping products. A zero tolerance policy is in effect and students who are found in violation of the Harbord and/or TDSB Code of Conduct or Nest's Code of Conduct will be asked to leave. A parent/guardian will be called and the student will remain with a staff member until the parent/guardian arrives. Additional consequences will be applied if there is a breach in the Code(s), including suspension and a denial of entry for any further evening events this school year. This includes Prom.

We would ask that you have a conversation with your student prior to the event, so that we can ensure all students come to the event understanding these expectations. In doing so, we are certain the students will have a great evening.
